

At Anchor in Umata.

1867

Friday March 22 1867

Begin with good weather and moderate wind from E. by N. Waking up towards Umata the watering place, at dusk came to anchor full sail and made every thing snug, middle part wind and weather the same, latter part wind and weather the same employed in rafting off water.

Saturday March 23

Begin with good weather, still rafting off water, middle part good weather, latter part the same finishing getting water and got under way bound to the anchorage in the bay.

Sunday March 24

Begin with good weather and fresh breeze from off the land, at 1.30 P.M. came to anchor in the bay, paid out a sufficient scope full sail and made every thing snug, middle part clear with light air from off the land.

Monday March 25

Begin with good weather and moderate wind from off the land which continues throughout the day, the starboard watch kept on liberty.

Tuesday March 26

Fine weather throughout 24 hours, the starboard watch still ashore, the usual ship's duties going on.

Wednesday March 27

These 24 hours begin and end as the previous the starboard watch now on board, two men minding Manuel Francis, and Matthew Souza.

At Anchor at Guam

Thursday March 28

Fine weather throughout 24 hours, the starboard watch kept on liberty, the usual ship's duties going on, the two men still minding.

Friday March 29

Good weather still continuing during these 24 hours, but little doing on board the ship being nearly ready for sea, the starboard watch still ashore, the two men still absent and now deserting.

Saturday March 30

Fine weather throughout 24 hours, with moderate wind from off the land, the starboard watch return.

Sunday March 31

Good weather throughout 24 hours with moderate wind from off the land all quiet on board ship, the two deserters not yet taken.

Monday April 1st

Begin with good weather and light wind from off the land which continues throughout the middle and latter part, peace and quietness in the ship.

Tuesday April 2

The usual good weather prevails throughout 24 hours, some little light ship's duties going on aboard ship, the two deserters not yet taken.
