Sunday April 14th 1867

Begins with strong wind from S.W. ship
on different tacks last part wind W ship
by the wind N.W. with all prudent sail set

Begins with strong wind from W with
pleasant weather ship by the wind N.W.
middle part light last part calm employed
repairing a boat and other jobs about ship

Begins with moderate wind from S.W. ship
steering S.W. by S all sail set middle part
the same last part wind S.E. and pleasant

Begins with fresh wind from W by S with
smoke weather ship head S.W. by S middle
part wind N.W. at 1 A.M. saw the Say
Island of the Bonens last part went
to the N. with all prudent sail set

Thursday April 18th

Begins with light weather N.W. ship beats
up to the north Island of the Bonens
at 5 P.M. Mr Lewis the passenger took a
boat and went on shore to see his family
now he goes the season in the ship
middle part up and on last part
beat in to the harbour and anchor
with the starboard anchor gave the
35 fathoms of chain employed repair
the main top sail and jib

At the Bonen Islands

Friday April 19th

Begins with fresh wind from S.E. and pleasant
ship at anchor middle and last part wind
from S. to S.W. with thick rainy
weather waiting for the wind to shift
all ready for sea so ends this day

Saturday April 20th

Begins with light wind from S. with heavy
rain middle and last part the same ship
at anchor at 10 wind from N. took anchor
stead out by the wind N.W. with all
sail set Mr Lewis on board for the season

Sunday April 21st

Begins with strong wind from N.W.
with rain ship by the wind N.W. all
prudent sail set at 2 P.M. saw Spencer
Islands going quick to N. land no chance
middle and last part wind S.E. and pleasant
steering N.W. by S all sail set saw fin backs

Monday April 22nd

Begins with fresh wind from S.W. with
pleasant weather middle part steered S.W. by S
at 4 A.M. saw White rock bearing S.W. by S
at 10 saw St Peters Island bearing N.W.

Tuesday April 23rd

Begins with fresh wind from W with thick
weather steering S.W. middle and last
part wind S.W. with thick smoke weather
passing showers of rain steering S.W. by S
with all sail set saw nothing Harold
employed at various jobs about ship
