Wednesday April 24th

Begins with strong wind from NW, with
with rugged weather all sail set steering
NW by N. Shifted the jib middle and last
part the same weather hands employed
Lat obs 34° 42' N
Long obs 144° 21' E

Thursday April 25th

Begins with strong wind from NW, with
steering NW by N. with all prudent sail
employed repairing the main sail tack
In starboard hull Boat at 7 P.M. a gale
from NW took in all sail to close
reefed top sails and fore top mast
stay sail ship head by NW last part
moderate set all sail employed repairing
the main sail and other jobs about ship
Lat obs 34° 42' N
Long obs 146° 24' E

Friday April 26th

Begins with moderate wind from S, with
steering NW by N. middle part calm last
part light from S, NW with pleasant
weather employed repairing the spar
and painting a boat and other jobs
Lat obs 35° 35' N
Long obs 147° 35' E

Saturday April 27th

Begins with light wind from S, with
with pleasant weather steering NW by N.
all sail set middle and last part
breeze wind from S, with overcast
weather employed repairing the
jib jib and other jobs about ship
Lat obs 37° 55' N
Long obs 148° 20' E

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Sunday April 28th

Begins with fresh wind from S, with
with thick overcast weather steering NW by N.
with all drawing sail set middle part
wind S, with rain last part wind S, and
thick at N. the wind from S, NW and fresh
Lat obs 40° 41' N
Long obs 149° 00' E

Monday April 29th

Begins with strong wind from S, NW, with
ship with prudent sail set by the wind, S, NW,
middle part light last part fresh from S, NW, steady
Lat obs 42° 28' N
Long obs 150° 03' E

Tuesday April 30th

Begins with strong wind from NW, steering
NW by N, with all sail set same time backs middle
part wind S, NW and pleasant middle and last
part fresh wind from S, NW with smoky weather
steering NW by N, with all drawing sail
Lat obs 45° 09' N
Long obs 151° 02' E

Wednesday May 1st

Begins with strong wind from S, NW, steering
NW by N, with all drawing sail employed
mending the old jib at 8 P.M. blowing
heavy took in all sail to close reefed top
sails and fore top mast stay sail by the
wind, S, NW, last part thick and more
moderate set all sail ahead NW by N, at 11
took in light sails by the wind S, NW,
Lat obs 46° 22' N
Long obs 152° 20' E

Thursday May 2nd

Begins with fresh wind from S, NW, with thick
weather middle part the same last part calm
with fog and rain ship head different way
Lat obs 46° 00' N
Long obs 152° 00' E
