1867

Friday May 3rd

Begins with calm fog and rain
at 4 P.M. light wind from NW ship by
the wind NNE all sail set at 6 A.M. saw
Marican Island having NW by N dist 25 miles
Lat obs 46.46 N
Long Chron 152.22 E

Saturday May 4th

Begins with fresh wind from NW by N ship by
the wind N at 8 P.M. entered the passage
between Marican and Tetay Islands last part
blowing heavy from NW by N ship by the wind
N with all prudent sail set saw nothing

Lat by act 47.20 N
Long do 153.00 E

Sunday May 5th

Begins with strong wind from NW by N with
more pleasant weather ship by the wind N
with all prudent sail set last part moderate
from NW by N set all sail steered NW by N

Lat obs 49 = 07.01
Long Chron 151.44 E

Monday May 6th

Begins with moderate wind from NW by N
steering NW by N, N by N with all sail
set at 8 P.M. saw the ice shortened sail
middle part ship on different tacks
last part blowing fresh from SE by S
ship heading different ways working
to the NW NW saw plenty of ice

Lat by act 49.50 N
Long do 152.10 E

Tuesday May 7th

Begins with light weather from W and
pleasant ship in the sea working to the N
with prudent sail set middle and last
part the same plenty of drift ice

Lat obs 51 = 18.01
Long Chron 151.24 E

In the Ochotsk Sea In the Ice

Wednesday May 8th

Begins with fresh wind from NW ship working
to the NW in the ice with moderate full
set middle part aback on different tacks
at 11 30 P.M. in evening ship came in contact
with ice knocked the lead shoving on the cut
water and 2 part of the false cutwater
last part very light weather and plenty of ice
ship on different tacks to keep clear of ice

Lat obs 57.25 N
Long Chron 159.22 E

Thursday May 9th

Begins with light wind from N with
thick cloudy weather ship heading dif-
ferent ways with prudent sail set plenty of ice
middle and last part the same no whales

Lat obs 57.21 N
Long Chron 159.33 E

Friday May 10th

Begins with light wind N with thick
cloudy weather ship by the wind ENE all
prudent sail set plenty of ice round
last part wind NW by N ship heading to the NNE
all sail set by the wind no ice round

Lat obs 57.25 N
Long Chron 152.16 E

Saturday May 11th

Begins with light weather from NW by N
ship by the wind N with all sail set
middle and last part wind SE by E with
cloudy weather ship steering to NW considerable
ice but scattered so ends this day no whales

Lat obs 57.50 N
Long Chron 152.17 E

Sunday May 12th

Begins with light weather from SE by E ship
working to the NW last part thick fog
steering to NW by N plenty of ice round

Lat by act 52.10 N
Long do 151.20 E
