

March 3rd Fine weather running before the wind heading N.W. painting the Starboard and Leeward mast took a new boat off of the house and marked it ready for painting at 5 O'clock P.M. lowered away for Black Fish but without success Lat 37° 22' S

4th Fine weather strong breeze and fair got a package this morning painting the Bow boat broke out for Molasses, rice, bread water, sugar, and tea, killed 6 chickens and one flew over board, saw black fish and Hump backs. Lat 35° 16' S

7th Pleasant weather running before the wind heading N.W. saw grasshoppers the old man is not very well. 3 men sick from the effects of port. Lat 33° 12' S

8th Pleasant weather running before the wind heading N.W. the weather is a growing quite warm making spun yarn and to work on the fore top mast rigging Lat 36° 31' S

9th Pleasant weather strong breeze steering N.N.W. making spun yarn, turned in the top mast rigging put new rattles on the main top mast broke out for flour and beans saw fin backs and Black fish Lat 37° 56' S

10th Fine weather running before the wind heading N.W. by N. the wind has not altered 3 points since we left San Pedro making stow mats for the fore top mast rigging to work on the main top mast rigging broke out the sail for the carpenter is a painting ship Lat 35° 10' S

March 11th Fine weather strong breeze heading N.W. rattling down the main and fore top mast served the upper bob stay and set it up. painted the ears in the boats making spun yarn broke out for beef and pork put anew belt rope on the fore top gallant standing Lat 23° 9' S

12th Rained all last but cleared off very pleasant this morning making spun yarn rattling down the main and fore top mast rigging made a sword mat for the top mast sprands saw a sail on our lee beam weighed boats crews to night to settle a dispute between the 1st and 2nd mate they weighed as follows
