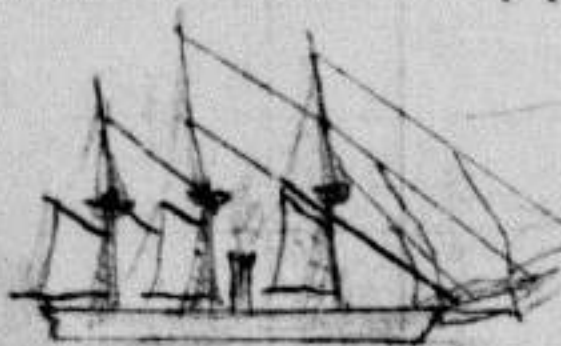


April 14th Fine weather light breeze steering W. by N. broke out for water saw for porpoise cow fish fin backs sharks cuttlefishes skip jacks. Dolphins every thing but sperm or right whale. Lat 12° 30' N. Long 124° 10' W

15th Pleasant weather light breeze heading N. by E. Caught a very large cow fish last night. His bladder not being good we threw it overboard. Saw a steamer this morning on our star beam. sent down the fore top gallant, lifts and repaired them put 2 chafing mats on the main scuppers. Broke out the main hold for coals and several small articles. Caught a small Dolphin this noon and cooked him. Lat 13° 18' N

16th Fine weather strong breeze heading W. broke out for beef and pork mackerels vinegar rice sugar cheese a barrel of sounds and bayonet put a new shackle in the main top sail to. caught a porpoise last night Lat 13° 30' N. Long 125° 17' W

17th Fine weather strong breeze and squally to the windward. steering W. by N. took the potatoes out from the after hold spread them on deck dried and sorted them over put a part of them in the round house and rest of them in the hold. Byron and James came on deck today after being below 12 days apiece. Mr. Campbell is worse to day over hauled the fore top sail blocks and cleaned them. Lat 14° 12' N. Long 123° 12' W



April 18th Pleasant weather strong S. E. trade steering W. by N. had a heavy squall last night. we have averaged about 9 knots for the last 24 hours. Lat. 15° 20' N. Long 127° 4' W

19th Fine weather strong breeze steering W. by N. broke out for flour water bread rum and cheese packed down 8 cases in liquor and 4 in slush. men employed on various small jobs. Long 129° 20' W. Lat. 16° 12' N

20th Fine weather strong breeze heading W. by N. broke out for shacks broke out the after hold to the ground tier and stored back again so as to make more room. the weather made a hose tub. took the steering to the apart. Lat 16° 49' N

21st Fine weather strong breeze from the S. E. scraped and slushed the main top mast and the top gallant mast coopers making deck buckets repaired the main top gallant standing sail set up the bowsprit shrouds making iron and loose shacks and various other small jobs. Lat 17° 22' N. Long 125° 9' W

22nd Beautiful weather light breeze heading W. by N. set up the main top gallant and top gallant jammers coopers making deck buckets cleaned and oiled four sand cuts airing bedding. set up the Mizzen stay squally in the after noon. Lat 18° 10' N. Long 124° 30' W
