

May 1st This weather part of the day
the wind tided this morning and
we made sail steering our course
to caught an allieore and cracked
it we have lost the tracks
and now are in the variable winds
Lat 36° 30' N.

Sunday 2nd Raining and squally had wind
steering N. N. W. under double reef
top sails no mast heads on
account of the heavy sea on
Lat 37° 26' N.

3rd Raining part of the day strong
breeze steering N. repaired the
cooler, strengthened the furl out & main
top sail feet ropes. Lat 39° 36' N.

4th Raining and squally steering
N. part of the day and
full and by the rest the
weather is a growing quite
cool got a cask out of
main hatch for rain water
Lat 31° 44' N.

5th Raining and squally steering full
and by heading N. E. the main
top gallant sheet parted to night
the cooper has been to work
6 days making 1 quart of worm
pegs. Starboard and bow beam
got a new spade each. sun obscure
no latitude.

6th Pleasant and squally under double
reefed top sails all hands making
humps made a spade sheath
one of the foremast hands was sent
up in the main top gallant canvas

May 7th (2 Hours)
trees for guavelling made a bomb
lure box for the old man
broke out for water but and
park steering full and by
heading N. E. by N. Lat 34° 30' N.

8th Squally and rainy steering N.
made a place at the fore to harness
cross-ries for standing mast heads
in cold weather broke out for
but set up the starboard fore
top mast, and top gallant back
stays the foot rope to the fly
jib boom parted to day and came
very near dropping two men overboard
we had to double reef top sails
at 7 o'clock N. Lat 35° 10' N.

9th Pleasant weather strong wind
under double reef top sails in
forenoon all sail out in the
afternoon steering N. killed old
Dick a hog we got at the
Cape de Verde Islands porpoises are a
playing around the ship but cannot get any
broke out for butter. Dick is sick again
with the Asthmy making sheaths
Lat 36° 20' N.

Sunday 9th Light breeze pleasant weather heading
N. with standing sails all out
saw fin backs this morning we
had a nice dinner to day out of
old Dick Lat 38° 0' N.

10th pleasant weather light breeze from
the S. steering N. set up the jib
and fly jib stays sent up the cutting
blocks saw fin backs and killers
saw 4 seals on a log. Lat 39° 20' N.
