

August a whale to day up to the windward of
 30th saw whales this morning lowered all
 1858 4 boats the Starboard Boat got fast and
 the iron drewed last him broke out for
 beef and park.

September Hazy weather strong breeze from the N. steering
 31st on the wind under double reefed top sails
 1858 trying out oil lowered 3 boats for Bone
 heads but lost the run of them started to
 come on board the Starboard boat got fast
 to a ship such whale but the iron drewed
 4 ships in sight sun obscure.

September Thick fog most of the day strong breeze
 1st from the N. steering on the wind
 1858 under double reefed top sails finished trying out
 at 10 A.M. stowed down the oil
 gammed with the ship Mary of Edgar
 Town Capt. Jents. twenty three months out
 nine hundred bbls. of oil broke out for
 nothing. sun obscure.

2nd Pleasant weather most of the day light
 breeze from the N. steering on the wind
 slowing down oil gammed with the Mary
 and Susan of New Bedford 18 months out
 1,000 bbls. of oil while gamming with her
 saw whales lowered for them the Starboard
 boat got fast to and killed a Bull
 whale got him along side to night and
 cut him in 2 ships in sight saw plenty
 whales.



3rd Clear weather most of the day strong breeze
 from the N. steering on the wind under
 double reefed top sails breaking out the
 fore mid after hold and making men
 storage saw the ship Hudson trying out
 also saw plenty Bow Head whales but to

September rough to lower for them at 6 O'clock P.M.
 3rd had to close reefed the main top sail blowing a
 1858 gale of wind from the N.E.

4th Hazy weather still blowing a gale of wind
 from the N.E. trying to under close reefed
 main top sail the gale died away at 1
 O'clock P.M. started the fire under the try pots
 spoke the Bark Helen Mear of New Bedford
 6 hundred bbls. of oil 3 ships in sight

5th Blowing a gale of wind from the N.E.
 5th trying to under close reefed main top sail
 trying out oil broke out beef and park
 began to bunch the beef and park
 to day 8 bunches to a bbls snowing
 most of the day Sat 71st 2nd st.

6th Snowing most of the day light breeze
 from the N. finished trying out oil to
 day saw whales at noon lowered all 4 boats
 but without success a ship to the windward
 of got a whale to day the whales are going
 to the windward very fast.

7th Fine weather light breeze from the N. steering
 on the wind cruising for whales saw
 in the morning lowered all 4 boats the
 Starboard Boat got fast to a Bull whale
 killed him and got him along side cut him
 by 3 O'clock P.M. started the fire under the
 try pots at 7 O'clock broke out the fore hold
 ready for stowing oil 2 ships in sight one of
 them got a whale this afternoon Sat 71st 12.



8th Pleasant weather light breeze from the N. steering
 cruising under short sail saw whales at 7
 O'clock this morning lowered all 4 the main
 Boat got fast to a cow whale killed her
 and got her along side and cut her in by 6
 O'clock P.M. trying out oil.
