

October 6th 1858. Hazy weather most of the day & strong breeze from the S.E. until 10 o'clock. then we got the wind from the N. running before the wind & steering S. by W. unbuttoned the fore top sail and hoisted a new cotton Duck fore top sail. broke out for water. sun obscure no recording

7th Blowing a moderate gale from the N. running before it & steering S. by W. and S. S. W. put on new main top gallant buntlines last night coopers lost his jacket and board to day Lat 5° 45' 0" N Long 178° 50' W.

8th Fine weather light breeze from the N. running before the wind & steering S. W. by W. put on new shaping mat on the foot of the main top sail unbuttoned the main top gallant sail and hoisted on an old one. repaired the main top sail and main top gallant foot ropes. Lat 5° 51' 13" N

9th Light squally weather strong breeze from the N. W. and W. steering S. W. by S. broke out for beef pork and water. Lat 5° 56' 0" N Long 178° 10' E.

10th Sunday Pleasant weather strong breeze from the W. at W. with snow squalls & steering S. W. by W. part of the day and on the wind the east headland of S. by W. Lat 5° 53' 2" N

11th Hazy weather light breeze from the W. at W. steering on the wind heading S. W. repaired the fly jib and main sail all hands got tobacco to day 3 lbs. each. Lat 5° 41' 20" N

12th Pleasant weather light breeze from the S. E. W. steering on the wind heading S. E. raised land this morning at 5 o'clock 12 miles to the Eastward of us it was the West end of Fox Islands. at 10 o'clock A.M. a spring up a gale of

October 12th 1858. wind from the S. E. have her to under close reefed main top sail. latter part of the day blowing in living gale from the S. E. sun obscure.

13th Fine weather most of the day strong breeze from the N. E. steering S. by E. under short sail in account of a very heavy head sea in the gale carried away our fore top mast cross trees. repaired the fore top gallant sail. Lat 5° 52' 52" N

14th Fine weather light breeze from the N. W. running before the wind & steering S. E. by E. broke out for coffee beans rice onions water and oil to burn & scraping bone in the afternoon unbuttoned the cables and stowed the in the cable pen. saw fin back in hole close to. Lat 5° 57' 4" N Long 178° 30' E.

15th Fine weather light breeze from the W. at W. running before the wind heading S. S. E. & scraping and curing bone all day. Lat 5° 51' 5" N Long 178° 50' E

16th Fine weather light breeze from the N. W. running before the wind & steering S. by S. & scraping and curing bone until noon then it came up rainy and squally. broke out of a loaf and pork. Lat 4° 55' 4" N Long 178° 30' E.

17th Sunday Hazy weather light breeze from the W. running before the wind & steering S. until 2 o'clock P.M. then sprung up a gale of wind from the S. E. close reefed the main top sail at 2 o'clock P.M. and hove her to on the Starboard tack. Lat 5° 5' 2" N Long 176° 20' E.

18th Pleasant weather strong breeze from the S. E. W. steering S. and S. by E. at 2 o'clock it blew so hard we dare not send her any longer & have her to under close reefed main top sail main spruce and fore top mast & top sail. took every thing out of the hold and put all tackle on the deck sun obscure
