

November 22nd 1858. of whale bone on board of the Mountain. Have for New Bedford. sh. will sail in about 3 weeks from now. at 5 o'clock in P.M. we sailed away from the Wave and the Eliza Adams came in our place to discharge her oil and bone. all hands ashore to night.

23rd Fine weather cooper setting up casks broke and the after hold for coffee sugar molasses and butter. got a raft of water of 2 casks. Byron got his discharge to day, and is in the hospital. Louis the Frenchman we got off of the Asaphson. got his discharge and sailed off to day. all hands ashore to night.

24th Fine weather cooper and all the watch setting up casks painting the outside of the ship. A tar barrel watch ashore on Liberty 2.8. each man.

25th Fine weather Starboard Watch ashore to day. 2.8. each. forward. cooper setting up casks. The Clipper ship Golden Eagle, and the City Sack sailed to day for New Bedford. they are on a race there is a 5. thousand dollars bet on them. all hands ashore to night.

26th Fine weather cooper setting up casks got a cooper from shore painting ship. The Starboard Watch got 6 dollars a piece to night. broke out for tobacco we got 4 lbs of tobacco. forward. all hands ashore tonight. Ellick got in the calaboose last night for being ashore after 7 o'clock. the Old Man paid his fine which was 2.8. and took him out.

November 27th Raining in the afternoon all hands employed in setting up casks. began to stow down pipes in the Hold. got a raft of water. all hands ashore to night the Starboard Watch got a dollar a piece. forward.

28th Fine weather the Clipper Ship Elizabeth C. Willits sailed to day for New Bedford. all hands ashore to day.

29th Fine weather setting up casks got 3 rafts of water and stowed them down. the fore hold to day is the King's birth day as here to day is a great Holiday with them ashore all hands ashore to night the Starboard Watch got one 1.8 a piece forward.

30th Fine weather setting up casks. our cooper is sick to day. got a raft of water. painting ship. put in a new davitt for the starboard boat. the ship carpenters are to work repairing the starboard bow. shifted the cables from one pen into the other. the Starboard Watch got 1.8. a piece forward. to night

1st Raining weather coopers sick to day. the other coopers is to work setting up casks. could not work this afternoon on account of the rain.

2nd Dec 1858. Fine weather cooper sick to day. the other left this morning. got a raft of water and stowed it down. the Clipper Bark Francis Palmer sailed to day for San Francisco. she took the U. S. Mail. the Starboard Watch got a 1.8 a piece forward. all hands ashore.

3rd Fine weather got another cooper from ashore. cooper is sick yet. got 30 barrels of potatoes from Boston to day. the caulkers are to
