

May. Pleasant weather strong breeze from the N. W.
 7th steering along the main body of ice to the westward.
 1858 broke out beef saw nothing sun obscure.

8th Fine weather light breeze from the S. W.
 steering on the wind running along the ice to the
 westward. saw a fin back whale. also a plenty seals.
 sun obscure no reckoning.

9th Hazy weather blowing a moderate gale from the S. W.
 Lying to under close reefed main top sail heading
 S. S. E. saw a fin back whale.

10th Foggy weather blowing a moderate gale from the S. W.
 Lying to under close reefed main top sail drove a new
 wheel rope. Lat 59. 30. N.

11th Fine weather light breeze from the S. E.
 steering on the wind heading S. by W. scraped
 and skurled the fore and main top masts. ice ahead at
 8. called P. M. Lat 59. 29. N. Long. 174. 35. W.

12th Foggy weather light breeze from the S. E. Lying
 with the fore yard shrouled aback most of the day.
 the fog being so thick we could not run. ice all
 around us saw two rip suck whales. this morning
 broke out water and a barrel of oil to burn run salt
 water into some fresh water casks down below.

13th Pleasant weather light breeze from the N. W.
 steering to the westward amongst the ice at
 6. O'clock P. M. raised Bow Head whales in the
 ice to the windward of us. could not get near
 enough to lower for them. Lat 60. 00. N.
 Long. 177 0. W.

14th Pleasant weather light breeze from the N. W.
 steering on the wind beating up along the ice
 to the northward broke out molasses. beef and pork
 sun obscure. no reckoning.

May 15th Fine weather light breeze from the N. W. running
 down along the main body of ice to the southward
 and westward. saw very heavy ice. also saw some
 walrus and seals. Lat 60. 18. N. Long 175. 30. W.

16th Pleasant weather light breeze from the W. running
 along the ice to the southward and westward. the
 sprits lowered away and shot 2 bulls. saw a fin
 back whale. Lat 59. 30. N. Long. 175. 50. W.

17th Pleasant weather light breeze from the N. steering
 on the wind beating up along the ice to the westward
 broke out beef vinegar and molasses sugar.
 saw nothing Lat 59. 20. N.

18th Fine weather light breeze from the S. E. running
 along the ice to the southward and eastward
 saw fin back whales. shot a duck and 2 bulls to day
 Inscore and Mersham. had a set to this fore noon and
 Merchant got off with a black eye. the Old Man
 sent Inscore to mast head all day and no dinner
 Lat 59. 26. N. Long 174. 14. W.

19th Fine weather light breeze from the S. E. left
 the ice this morning steering on the wind heading
 S. E. raised a sail on our weather beam at 12 past 8

 we beat to the windward and found her whaling
 after Bow Heads. lost the whales in the ice and she
 came down to us she proved to be the Omega of
 Odgar Town. Capt 19 months out 7,000 bbls
 of oil. her Skipper came aboard of us. Lat 59. 58.

20th Fine weather light breeze from the N. W. running
 down along ice to the westward saw rip suck whales
 and fin back. Lat 60. 24. N.

21st Pleasant weather light breeze from the N. W.

 running along the ice to the southward and eastward
 broke out for beef pork and flour. saw 2 ships to
 the leeward of about 1 mile one of them is trying.
