

October 7th Fine weather Starboard Watch ashore to day 2^d apiece got a cask of water, broke out molasses and vinegar and broke out the after hold to find out how much beef and pork we have got. The ship *Officer B. Mize* came in to day a Danish Clipper bark came in loaded with freight, painted the Starboard side of the ship to day. all hands came on board to meet except Jack Parker and he is excited and put in the Calaboose.

8th Fine weather Starboard Watch ashore. 2^d apiece painted the Starboard side of the ship to day Parker's trial came off to day he was fined \$5 and costs fine and costs but he is to stay in the Calaboose until the ship sails. Jerry Tapples was excited and put in the Calaboose to day.

9th Sunday Fine weather all hands ashore to day. Jerry, Parker and Jack Bright are in the Calaboose.

10th Fine weather Jerry Tapples Jack Parker and Bright got out of the Calaboose to day. got some casks and a raft of water sent some hauling ashore. The ship *Robins* is laying off and on. got a new cook stove and set it up. The ship *Neve* was condemned to day.

11th Fine weather weather light breeze painted the Starboard side of the ship sold 3 casks of bread to the ship *Saratoga*. got 32 lbs of pork and beef. 6 lbs of molasses 2 kegs of Butter and some fish ashore. James Enos got his discharge to day Joe got his discharge and shipped to go home with us. Starboard Watch ashore to day on Liberty got 2^d apiece.

12th Fine weather Starboard Watch ashore on Liberty to day. got a raft of water this morning 9 casks. painted the yards and head gear. Starboard Watch got Liberty to day 2^d apiece forward.

13th Fine weather got a raft of water of water sent ashore 77 coils of tow lines to sell. The 1st Mate was taken sick last night with the Booboo fever.

14th Edward Green was sent ashore to take care of him sent all the sails. 6 ships came in to day.

15th Fine weather got another raft of water and stowed it down. sent 3 pipes of bread ashore sold 1 coil of cutting falls. The mate is some better to day. 3 ships came in to day. painted the Starboard side of the ship to day.

16th Fine weather got 80 lbs of potatoes. 2 casks of water. The mate is better to day. Parker. Harold is sick with the Booboo fever. also Carpenter is sick below. The Brig *Intilla*. The Bark *Francis Palmer* came in to day and brought the U.S. Mail.

17th Sunday Fine weather The Mate came on board this morning. Dick and Carpenter is about the same. The Bark *Murray & Susan*. George & Susan. came in to day. The old Man. Give us money to day 2^d apiece.

18th Fine weather hove up our anchors this morning ready for sea got 31 lbs of potatoes and 4 or 5 lbs of sweet potatoes. James Irish recovered last night. The 1st Mate of the Bark *Francis Palmer* killed the Steward last night by kicking him. The Mate made his escape but was caught again. he was put under 6,000 \$ bonds. To appear before court on Thursday next. The Pilot came on board at 3 O'clock P.M. and we went out side to lay off and on until tomorrow morning.

19th Fine weather moderate breeze from the N.E. lay off and on until this morning sent a boat ashore for the Captain he came off about 11 O'clock at the square in our yards and steered. S. by. E. home ward Bremen. The Old Man did not find Jim Schiff this time. got our anchors on the boom and stowed down the cables. Took George Antine out of the Starboard Watch and put him in the Starboard Watch.
