Boat. came and took us up and and brought us on board got the whale alongside doubled reefed the main top sail and lay to with the two whales alongside took the Bar Boat and put her on the house. standing by matches.

27th Sunday. Fine weather light breeze from the N. E. steering S. S. E. cut in the two whales (we got yesterday) to day. and cleared away the heads. Don Hopper went below sick. to day. saw plenty of Blue Charks around the ship.

28th Dec. Fine weather light breeze from N. E. steering S. S. E. started the fire under the try pots at 6 o'clock. A. M. Hopper is below sick yet. broke out for beef and pork. broke out 2 casks of bread. and put it in the cabin. Lat 27. 5. S.

28th Dec. Pleasant weather strong breeze from the S. S. E. steering on the wind heading S. W. under long le reefed top sails. By one o'clock. broke a cask of bread out and put it in the cabin. Hopper came on deck to day. Lat 27. 45. S.

30th Dec. Pleasant weather strong breeze from the S. S. E. steering on the wind heading E. under double reefed top sails. finished trying out at 7 o'clock. A. M. cleaned the whales galley and cut them up broke out 6 cask of fresh water and threw it overboard. for casks to put oil in. Lat. 27. 33. S.

December 1st Fine weather light breeze from the E. steering S. E. scooped the oil and washed ship.
 Lat 27 45. S.

2nd Dec. Fine weather light breeze from the E. steering S. S. E. took half of the horse and dried it.
 Lat 28 54. S.

December 3rd Fine weather light breeze from the N. E. steering S. S. E. finished trying some to day. put chaffing in the pot stoves. caught a flying fish this morning. Click is sick with the Asthma and is off duty. S.

4th Sunday. Fine weather light breeze from the N. E. steering S. S. E. saw sharks. albacores. Pilot fish and other small fish around the ship. Click is below. George. Maggs is sick and off duty.

5th Dec. Fine weather moderate breeze from the E. steering our course. S. S. E. broke out the after Hallet found two new lead casks of Masses. turned our Stern. Oil. about 1 o'clock in A. M. George and Click is below sick. Lat 31 10. S.

6th Dec. Pleasant weather strong breeze from the E. S. E. steering S. S. E. under doubled reefed top sails broke out beef, pork, and water. finished stowing the fore and after Hatch. saw a whale to night supposed it to be a Right Whal. George and Dick is below sick. Click came on deck to day. Lat 33. 12. S. Long 171. 54. W.

7th Dec. Hazy weather strong breeze from the N. E. steering S. S. E. under doubled reefed top sails. George and Dick are below yet. Lat 36. 1. S.

8th Dec. Hazy weather steering S. S. E. raised N. E. raise new fore topmast stay sail. halyards and fore luff lines broke out beef and pork. George is below yet. Dick came on deck. to day. sent down the forward blocks. Lat 38. 36. W. Lat 38. 24. S.

9th Dec. Rainy weather strong breeze from the S. E. steering on the wind heading S. S. E. George Maggs is below yet. divided the last two whales. killed amongst the ship crew. to day. saw above no observation.
