first part of this day begins with a good breeze from S. S. W. Steering S. E. under all sail at 6 A.M. took in the 3d & 4th Gallant Sail Middle part Strong winds from S. S. W. took in the Main & 3rd Gallant Sail flying jib and Mizzen. 3d Staysail and tacked Ship to the West. Latter part took in the gaff topsail the Ship heading W by the wind Employed in picking up Spun yarn so ends these 24 hours with squally weather

Wednesday July 26th this day begins with Strong winds from S. S. W. Steering W by the wind at 4 P.M. tacked Ship to the Eastward heading E. S. E. by the wind Middle part Strong winds from S. to S. S. W. Latter part - Set the fly jib gaff topsail & 4th Gallant sail Steering S. E. by the wind so ends this day Lat 7° 35' N Long 151° 30' West

Thursday July 27th first part strong breezes from S. S. W. Steering S. E. under all sail Middle part winds from S. S. W. to W. S. W. took in the fly jib and set it again latter part wind S. W. by S. Employed in getting out water so ends one Sail in sight Lat 6° 34' N Long 141° 30' W

Friday July 28th first part of this day Strong breezes from S. S. W. Steering S. E. by the wind Middle part Strong winds from S. W. to W. S. W. Steering from S. S. E. to S. by E took in the fly jib 3d & 4th Gallant Sail & Mizzen Topmast Staysail Latter part Strong winds from S. S. E. to S. W. so ends Employed in grafting or pointing the cutting falls

Sunday July 30th all these 24 hours Strong breezes from S. S. W. to S. W. Steering from W. to W. N. W. under all sail so ends Lat 4° 14' N Long 141° 52' W

Monday July 31st first and Middle part moderate breezes from S. W. to S. S. W. Steering from W. to W. N. W. at 3 P.M. tacked Ship heading S. S. E. so ends Employed in overhauling old rigging Lat 4° 00' N Long 141° 28' W

Tuesday August 1st first and Middle part Strong breezes from S. W. by S. Steering S. E. by S. under all sail Latter part tacked Ship heading W. wind S. S. W. Employed in breaking out for beef and pork & flour

Wednesday August 2nd all these 24 hours Strong breezes from S. S. W. to S. W. Steering on different tacks by the wind under all sail employed in getting out bread &c Lat 3° 25' N Long 141° 08' W

Thursday August 3rd all these 24 hours moderate breezes from S. to S. S. W. Steering to the Westward by the wind under all sail one Ship in sight

Friday August 4th all these 24 hours Light breezes from S. E. to S. Steering from S. S. W. to S. W. under all sail one sail in sight so ends this day Lat 00° 40' N Long " West
