Friday Aug 18th first part moderate winds from E. S. E.
Steering to the Southward by the wind took in the No. 3 sail
gaff top sail & fly jib Middle part took in
the No. 3 sail Latter part set the fly jib
one sail in sight Lat 21° 40' S Long 30° 05' West

Saturday August 19th first part Strong winds from E. to E. S. E.
Steering from S. to S. E. by the wind Middle part took in the
fly jib & No. 3 sail Latter part made all sail
so ends one sail in sight Lat 21° 05' S Long 31° 35' West

Sunday Aug 20 first part Strong winds from E. to E. by N. Steering to
the Southward and Eastward by the wind at 1 1/2 P. M. a
man fell overboard lored the S boat and picked him
up Middle wind N. E. Steering S. E. by E Latter
part Strong breezes from N. N. E. under all sail
set the No. 3 Standing sail & No. 4 Standing sail
nothing in sight but finback Lat 25° 45' South
Long " west

Monday Aug 21st first part Strong breezes from
N. E. to N. W. Steering S. E. by E under all sail
Middle part moderate gales from N. W. to
N. N. W. took in the light sails furlled the
No sail & double reefed S. J. sail Latter
part double reefed the No. 3 sail &
reefed the No sail Lat 29° 48' S Long 24° 19' W

Tuesday Aug 22nd first and Middle part
Moderate gales from S. S. W. Steering
E. S. E. under double reefed top sails & No. 3 sail
Latter part shook the reefes out of the No. 3
sail & set jib & Spanker. Lat 28° 40' S Long 21° 24'

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Wednesday Aug 23rd first part Strong winds from S. S. W.
Steering E. S. E. under all sail excepting
fly jib gaff top sail & fore top gallant sail
Middle part wind S. latter under all
sail Lat 20° 20' S Long 19° 15' West

Thursday Aug 24th first part moderate winds from W. S. W.
Steering E. S. E. under all sail at 4 P. M. sent down the
fore top gallant yard & sent in the fly jib & furlled the
No. 3 sail Middle moderate gales from N. W. took in the
No. 3 sail & doubled reefed the top sails Latter part
furlled the No. 3 top sail Lat " S Long " W

Friday Aug 25th first part light winds from W. S. W.
Steering S. E. by E at 3 P. M. set the No. 3 sail at 8
P. M. turned the reefes out of the top sails Middle wind
S. W. Steering S. E. by E Latter part made all sail
employed in little of every thing Lat 31° 51' S
Long 14° 28' W

Saturday Aug 26th Commences with moderate winds from
S. to S. W. Steering S. E. by E under all sail Middle
part took in the No. 3 Mast & No. 4 Gallant top sail
Strong winds Latter part Strong winds from W. S. W.
Steering S. E. by E Lat 32° 12' S Long 11° 14' West

Sunday Aug 27th this day begins with Strong winds
S. W. Steering S. E. by E at 5 P. M. Single reefed the
top sails and set No. 3 Gallant sail over it Middle
Strong winds from S. to S. W. Latter moderate winds
from S. E. to S. at 12 M. tacked to the Southward
so ends there 24 hours Lat 31° 55' S Long 8° 55' W

Monday Aug 28th Commences with Light winds from
E. to S. E. Steering to the Southward by the wind
under Single reefed top sail & No. 3 sail Middle
Strong winds N. E. Steering S. E. by E Latter under
all sail employed in breaking for water & Bread
Lat " S Long " W
