

Bound to Johanna Sept 11th 1854

Monday Sept 11th this day begins with moderate winds from N.W. Steering E under all sail carried away the fore top. Sn. Studingsail boom Middle took in the M. T. F. staysail & M. T. F. Studing sail & sent down the boom we sent up another F. T. M. Studingsail boom and set the studing sail strong winds latter part moderate winds from S.W. Steering E & E one sail in sight employed in getting out Coffee Flour water Rice and &c &c
No obs. Lat " S Long " E

Tuesday Sept 12th this Day Commences with light winds from S.W. to S. Steering E. & E. Saw land bearing from N. to N.W. Middle part Strong winds from S.E. heading S.W. took in all sail but fore top mast staysail and Mizzen staysail & close reefed Main & top sail. Latter Strong gales from S.E. Lat " S Long " E

Wednesday Sept 13th this Day begins with Strong gales from Middle part Strong winds from W. to N.W. Steering E. & E. under single reefed top sail & fore sail. Latter more moderate Made all sail I forgot to put it in at 5 minutes past 12 M. Shipped a sea on the Larboard bow stored in the bulworks but did no serious injure Lat 34 " 19 S Long 28 " 30 E

Thursday Sept 14th first part moderate winds from N.W. Steering E under all sail at 6 M. took in the light sails Doubled reefed the M top sail and closed reefed the fore & furled the Jib & M sail Middle at the Jib & M. M. most stay sail soon squally latter middle all sail moderate winds from W. N.W. to E. & E. made all sail & set the studingsails

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Friday Sept 15th this day Commences with moderate winds from S.W. to W. S.W. Steering E by N under all sail Middle Strong winds from W. to W. N.W. Latter part took in the Studingsails Steering E by N. 1/2 N Lat " S Long " E

Saturday Sept 16th first and Middle part Strong winds from S.W. to S. S.W. Steering E. N.E. under all useful sail Latter part sent up the fore top gallant yard and set the fore top gallant sail & rods one sail in sight Lat 28. 50 S Long 6. 10 East

Sunday Sept 17th this day begins with good weather and a good breeze from S. S.W. Steering N.E. by E under all sail Middle and latter the same Lat 27 " 10 S Long 37 " 15 E

Monday Sept 18th this day Commences with light winds S. S.E. Steering N.E. Middle calm Latter part light winds from N. N.E. Steering N.W. by the wind employed in splicing the fly jib boom Lat 26. 50 S Long 36. 50 E

Tuesday Sept 19th this begins with Strong breezes from N.E. Steering E by the wind at 3 P.M. the to the N.W. Steered N.E. 1/2 N took in the stay sails. F. T. F. sail and yaff top sail Middle Squally Strong winds from S.W. at the F. T. F. mast studingsail Latter the same Lat 25. 35 S Long 37. 45 East

Wednesday Sept 20th first and Middle part Strong winds from S.W. Steering N.E. 1/2 N under all sail that wood drag sent out the fly jib boom Latter light winds employed in breaking out for water Lat 20. 40 S Long 38. 18 East

Thursday Sept 21st first and Middle part Strong winds from S. S.W. Steering N.E. 1/2 E bent the fly jib & set it under all sail latter took in the fly jib & F. T. F. sail Lat 18. 25 S Long 40. 28 E
