 Moderate winds from S. S. E employed in Ship Duty
 Lat 16° 05' S Long 41° 50' E

Saturday Sept 23rd first part moderate winds from S
 Steering N. E under all sail employed in sending
 up the cutting blocks sent up the No royal yard
 and washing Ship in side & rove the old fore
 braces Middle and Latter part wind from
 S. W to S. S. W. Steering N. E by N employed in
 fitting the fluke chains bracking out Flour
 &c Lat " S Long " East

Sunday Sept 24th first part and Middle part
 moderate breeze from S Steering N. E
 Latter wind S. E at 5 P. M. under Middle
 and Johanna so ends Steering for the
 harbor no obs.

Monday Sept 25th first part winds from
 E all quarters Steering for the harbor halted
 up the cables and sent them at
 3 P. M. to come to anchor Latter employ-
 ed in bracking out the No back &
 after one and sent a raft of casks
 on shore to fill with water

Tuesday Sept 26th first part employed in pump-
 ing off the water out of the casks in the hold and
 filling the casks on shore at sun down got
 the raft along side and lashed them in
 Latter employed in running down the water
 and sent the raft on shore to fill again

Wednesday Sept 27th first part employed in filling
 Casks with water Latter part took the raft
 along side and lashed them in and stowed
 off the hold so ends lying at anchor
 in Johanna

Cruising in the Indian Ocean
 Thursday Sept 28 first part employed in getting the recruits
 on board Middle good weather at 1 P. M. hoove up the
 Amcor and made all sail with a light wind
 from E Steering N. E by the wind Latter employ-
 ed in getting the amors on the bow and stowing
 away the cables Lat 9° 43' S Long 43° 58' E

Friday Sept 29th first part light winds from E Steering
 N. E by the wind Middle part took in the
 No 1st Fullant sail fly jell & Mizzen top mast
 Staysail Latter took in the No top gallant

Saturday Sept 30th first part moderate wind
 under all sail Latter the same at 8 A. M.
 raised Sperm Whales at 11 A. M. Lored the boats
 and the W. O. struck so ends the whale not tur-
 ned up Lat 8° 10' S

Sunday Sept 31st

Sunday Oct 1st first part moderate winds from
 E. S. E at 1/2 past No hiled the whole at
 8 P. M. took the whale along side the other
 boats in chase at 1/2 past 5 P. M. the boats
 returned at 6 P. M. commenced cutting at
 8 P. M. finished Middle employed in clearing
 away the head Latter started the works
 standing on different the tacs by the
 wind Lat 7° 35' S Long 43° 58' E

Monday Oct 2nd this day begins with Strong winds from
 E. S. E Steering on different tacs by the wind
 employed in boylng Middle & Latter part the
 same at 8 A. M. finished boylng so ends this
 Lat 7° 38' S Long 44° 10' E
