Thursday Dec 14th first part light airs from N.E. steering to the W. Middle & latter part light winds from S.W. to S. W. this day bore the S. boat for a sulphur bottom but not taken Lat 4.34 N long 56.19 E

Friday Dec 15th all these 24 hours light airs and calms from S.W. steering to the W. by the wind sent down the S. boat to repair at 11 A.M. see Sp. Whales at noon however the boats & seconds then in chase Lat 4.34 N long 56.18 E

Saturday Dec 16th first part light winds from N.E. steering on diff track the boats in chase of the Wh. at 3 P.M. came on board with net empty. W. Middle & latter under all sail steering on diff track looks by the journal so ends this day here the S. boat again on sail in sight Lat 5.00 N long 57.34

Monday Dec 18th first part strong winds from N.E. steering S.W. under all sail the Bark Platina in sight at 4 P.M. Capt Inell went on board of the Platina at 8 P.M. returned steering E under single reefes latter part under all sail Lat 4.30 N long 56.58 E

Tuesday Dec 19th first part steering to the W. under all sail the wind from N.N.E. Middle part under shore sail steering N.W. by the wind latter part steering S.W. under all sail nothing in sight worth of notice Lat 4.14 N long 53.58 E

Wednesday Dec 20th first part strong winds from N. to N.N.E. steering to the S.W. Middle under shore sail steering by the to the wind to the N.W. latter part under all sail Lat 3.19 N long 52.15 E

Thursday Dec 21st first part steering S.W. Middle steering N.W. by the wind under shore sail latter part under single reefes topsails & courses m. 15

Friday Dec 22nd first part under single reefes Middle steering wind from N. to N.N.E. steering to the Westward by the wind latter under single reefes lat 4.15 E
