

Whale Jan 16th 1858 -
Tuesday Jan 16th all these 24 hours good
weather receiving night the L. watch ashore
on Liberty this morning the bark crew of
Fairhaven Capt Nelson 6 months out 10
the L. come to anchor in side

Wednesday Jan 17th ^{all} this good weather the
L. watch ashore on Liberty the Capt getting
what recruits he could

Thursday Jan 18th this day good weather
L. watch ashore on Liberty this morning
the L. went down to another place on
this Island for recruits he got some fish &
and other things this day the Station of
Westport Capt Allen 15. was out 4 to 5 p.
this fore noon the Station went ashore in
the boat with some things to get did not
have a permit to land them so the
Station took them and all and then in
chokey I don't know whether we shall
get them or not

Friday Jan 19th all this day fine weather
the L. watch ashore on Liberty

Saturday Jan 20th all these 24 hours good weather
the L. watch ashore on Liberty employed in
brushing out for boats got off to eastward
of anchor this day to of our men got in chokey

Sunday Jan 21st this day good weather the
L. watch ashore on Liberty took the boat out
of chokey

Monday Jan 22nd all this day good weather
all hands on board got our men out of chokey
doing not much of any thing

Tuesday Jan 23rd 1858 all this day good weather this morning we
took our anchor and set sail with a fair wind
but very light got out as far as the reef by towing
when the wind came a head and we let go anchor
closed up the sails & the Capt went ashore at
2 1/2 the boat returned at 8 the boat went
ashore again at 8 1/2 P. M. returned Capt &
all

Wednesday Jan 24th all this day good weather
and a light breeze from N. E. this morning
took the anchor & made sail employed in
beating out of the harbor slowed away the
cables and anchors and all

Thursday Jan 25th sea & weather all this day
good weather and a light wind from the S.
Steering to the Eastward by the wind under all
sail Middle the same latter almost
calm Lat 4. 32 S Long 56. 16 E

Friday Jan 26th all these 24 hours light airs
and calm from S. E. Steering to the E. N. E. by the
wind under all sail so ends this day
Lat 4. 40 S Long 57. 06 E

Saturday Jan 27th first part calm and
light airs from S. E. at 10 A. M. see a breach
called it a Sp. Whale at 2 P. M. see it
again at 3 P. M. lowered the boats the W.
5 miles dis. Chased the Whales until 6 P. M.
then came on board Middle & latter Steering
W. N. W. Wind S. E. so ends this day
Lat 4. 26 S Long 56. 23 E

Sunday Jan 28th all these 24 hours light
winds from S. Steering on Dift tacks by the
wind so ends this day Lat 4. 20. S
Long 57. 11 E

Monday Jan 29th all these 24 hours
light winds from S. to S. S. W. Steering Dift
courses so ends Lat 4. 28 S
Long 57. 38 E
