

Monday July 30th 1833
First part light breeze from the
Eastward shifting to the S by the wind
Employed in stowing away the goods
at 3 P.M. started the decks (Middie
part) bottom better part (Upper) under
beam. Employed in stowing by the wind under
all sail. Employed in stowing

Lat 14° 30' Long 41° 30' E

Tuesday July 31st first part light air
from S. Shifting to the wind Employed
in stowing at 3 P.M. to assist side
crushed of the ship. Middle part strong
breeze latter part looked out to the S.W.
under whole top sails & courses

Lat 14° 34' Long 41° E

Wednesday August 1st first part
light breeze from the S. Shifting to the
S.W. by the wind under double reefed bottom
part Shifting to the Westward by the wind
Employed in stowing down the side Lat 14° 28' P
Long 42° 28' E

Thursday August 2nd first part
light breeze from S. Shifting to the S.W. by
the wind under moderate sail employed in
stowing down at sundown finished Middle
part good weather. Latter employed in
stowing ship under all sail

Lat 14° 40' Long 42° 40' E

Friday August 3rd first part good
weather and a good breeze from S. Shifting
to the Westward by the wind
under all sail Employed in stowing
stipes and stowage down into
them Lat 14° 40' P
Long 41° 40' E

Saturday August the 4th 1833
First part light winds from the S. to
S. S. E. Shifting to the Eastward by the wind
under all sail at sundown took in the light
sails Middle and Latter Shifting on different
tacks so under all sail one sail in
Eight Employed in ship duty Lat 15° 30' P
Long

Sunday Aug 5th all these 24 hours light
winds from the S. S. E. Shifting on different
tacks by the wind under all sail so under
Eight Lat 15° 34' P Long 41° 14' E

Monday Aug 6th all these 24 hours light
winds from S. S. E. Shifting on different
tacks by the wind Middle part under
latter part strong breeze from S. to
S. S. E. Shifting S. S. W. & S. W. under all sail
Lat 14° 19' P Long 42° 04' E

Tuesday Aug 7th first part light
winds from S. S. E. to S. S. W. Shifting on
different tacks by the wind under all
sail latter part a good breeze from
S. S. E. Shifting to the S. W. by the wind at 1 P.M.
I will raise white smoke to the board
light off for them but did not ascertain
what it was so under the top sail
Employed in making a fly for beam

Wednesday Aug 8th all these 24 hours
good weather and a good breeze the most
part of time strong breeze from the
wind the wind from S. S. E. to S. S. W.
at 11 P.M. raised 14 miles on the
weather bar 6 or 7 miles S.W.
