 First part of this day a moderate breeze
 from S. by E. steering to the S. by the wind under
 all sail at 1 p. m. bore the boats for W.
 Whales at 2 p. m. in the wind - boat struck
 & the line got in the whales jaw & he bit the
 line off at 5 p. m. returned to the ship
 without success. Middle part nearly
 calm - latter part a good breeze from
 S. by E. steering E. S. E. by the wind under all
 sail - at 10 p. m. in sight in light

Lat 15° 49' Long 42° 59' E
 Friday Aug 10th this day begins with
 light breezes from S. steering to the westward
 at 10 a. m. a light wind from S. W.
 steering on dip - stuck by the wind under
 all sail - at 10 p. m. in sight in light
 Lat 15° 34' Long 43° 46'

Saturday Aug 11th first part light
 airs from S. by E. steering on dip - at 10 a. m.
 a fair wind - light winds from S. by E.
 steering to the Eastward by the wind
 at 10 p. m. a good breeze from E. by
 S. steering to the S. by the wind
 at 10 p. m. employed in putting a mast pole
 into the S. by E. one pole in light

Lat 15° 38' Long 43° 31' E
 Sunday Aug 12th first part light
 breezes from S. by E. steering to the S. by
 the wind at 1 p. m. spoke the Bark
 Marcella of Strabulford Capt Morton
 20 months out 223 Tons - Capt Morton
 came on board - Middle part calm
 latter part a good breeze from
 S. by E. steering on dip - at 10 p. m.
 in sight in light
 Lat 16° 01' Long 42° 33' E

Monday August 13th 1855
 First part light airs from all quarters steering E. S. E.
 under all sail Middle part light airs from S. by
 steering E. S. E. latter a light breeze from South
 at 10 p. m. under all sail Lat 15° 15' Long 42° 14' E

Tuesday August 14th first & Middle part
 Calm latter part light winds from S. by
 steering E. S. E. under all sail at 10 p. m. this
 day employed in washing our clothes
 Lat 15° 13' Long 42° 08' E

Wednesday Aug 15th first part light
 winds from S. by E. steering to the S. by E. and
 E. S. E. by the wind under all sail Middle
 Calm latter part a good breeze from S. by
 to S. E. steering to the Eastward by the wind
 at 10 p. m. this days work Bound for
 Johanna Lat 13° 02' Long 42° 00' E

Thursday Aug 16th first part light airs
 from S. by E. steering to the S. by E. and
 Johanna and Angella in sight Middle
 part calm latter part light winds from
 S. steering for Johanna harbor at 10 p. m. in sight

Friday Aug 17th first part light airs
 from the Southward steering for Johanna
 harbor under all sail Middle part
 the same latter part bore the boats
 and moved in at 10 p. m. came to anchor
 at 10 p. m. lying to anchor in Johanna harbor the
 guard watch is here on liberty this afternoon

Saturday Aug 18th Civil day
 at 10 a. m. there is a good weather this day the
 British watch ashore on liberty

Sunday Aug 19th at 10 a. m. there is a good weather
 the watch ashore on liberty
