First part good breezes from S.P.E. & a
Steering E by the wind middle light breezes
S.E. Steering on different tacks by the wind

Monday April 14th all these 24 hours
light breezes from E.P.E. to E.N.E.
Steering on different tacks by the wind
So ends this day

Tuesday April 15th first part of this day
light breezes from S.E. Steering E.N.E. by
the wind saw breaches off the weather bow
Middle and latter about the same so
So ends this day

Wednesday April 16th all these 24 hours
Good breezes from S. to S.E. Steering from
E.N.E. to E.P.E. by the wind employed
in ship duty

Thursday April 17th first part light
Winds from E.P.E. Steering S by the wind
Middle & latter light breezes from
S.E. Steering E.N.E. so ends

Friday April 18th first part light breezes from
S.E. Steering S.P.W. by the wind middle and
latter light breezes from S. Steering E.P.E.
so ends this day

Saturday April 19th first part light
breezes from S.E. Steering E.N.E. latter
about the same employed in breaking
out pork slops bread &c

Sunday April 20th first part of this day
Calm middle part a good breeze from
S.P.W. Steering E.N.E. latter light breeze
from S.E. to E. Steering to the northward by
the wind so ends this day

Barque Alto Monday April 21st 1856
First part light breezes from N.P.W. Steering N.E.
by the wind under all sail middle light
breezes from N.W. Steering S.E. by E
Latter light airs from all quarters and
some rain so ends this day

Tuesday April 22nd first part light
breezes from N.P.W. Steering E.S.E. middle
Calm latter part rainy with light airs from
all quarters

Wednesday April 23rd first & middle
Part fine breezes from N.P.E. Steering on
different tacks by the wind under all sail
Latter part about calm so ends

Thursday April 24th first part calm middle
Latter light airs from S.P.W. to S.E. Steering
the weather under all sail

Friday April 25th all these 24 hours light airs
from S.P.W. to S.E. Steering E.N.E. with Madagascar
in sight E employed in ship duty

Saturday April 26th first part light breezes
from N.P.W. Steering N.E. by E & Y. &
with the land in sight middle calm latter
light airs from S.E. Steering S.P.E.
so ends this day

Sunday April 27th first part light
breezes from S.P.W. to N.P.W. Steering
E.N.E. and N.E. by E the land and
no sail in sight the Capt. is sick &
we are bound into our bay Middle &
latter Steering from N.W. to W.
