S.E. steering E. N.E. all hands employ
in stowing down oil so ends
this Day Lat 11. 36 South

stowing off the after hold & Lat 10. 33

N. N. E. and N.E. by the wind under all
sail so ends this day Lat 10. 14 South

Thursday 12th all this day fine breezes
from S.E. steering on different tacks
by the wind under all sail we got out
water & bent a new Main sail

Lat 10. 44 S Long 44. 45 E

Friday 13th all these 24 hours light
breezes from S.E. to S.W. steering to
the Eastward by the wind Lat 10. 49 S

Long 44. 32 E

Saturday 14th first part light breezes
from S.W. steering S.E. by the wind
Middle some squally latter about the
same so ends this day Lat 00. 00

Sunday 15th first part light breezes
from S. steering E. S. E. under all sail
two sail in sight Middle & latter
steering on different tacks by the wind
with the land in sight off the weather
beam so ends No obs

Monday 16th all these 24 hours
light breezes from S. steering E. S. E.
by the wind under all sail employed
in ship Duty Lat 11. 43 S
