Tuesday June the 17th 1856
First part calm middle part A
good breeze from S to S.E. Steering W.S.W.
for Johanna at 11 A.M. came to anchor
we found the Peri & Platina in here

Wednesday 18th Civil Act
all these 24 hours fine weather
all hands employed in breaking out be-
tween decks & getting off our bread

Thursday 19th good weather employed
in getting off water and storing it down
So ends

Friday 20th all these 24 hours good
weather the S watch ashore on liberty

Saturday 21st all these 24 hours good weather
the S watch ashore on liberty employed in
fitting the bob stays

Sunday 22nd this day fine weather
the S watch ashore on liberty so ends

Monday 23rd all this day good weather
Employed in getting off recruits and
getting ready for sea the Peri sailed
last night

Tuesday 24th Sea Act
all these 24 hours fine weather
at 8 A.M. got under way in company
with the Platina bound to Pomba Bay
after wood at 1 1/2 P.M. spoke the
Elizabeth of Westport 20 months out
200 of Sp. so ends the wind from
all quarters

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Wednesday June the 25th 1856
First part calm middle light breeze from
S. Steering W.S.W. under all sail latter
strong winds from S.E. Steering
W.S.W. the Platina in company
Lat 13.05 S Long 82.45 E

Thursday 26th first part strong
breezes from S.E. Steering S.W. by W.
under all sail middle & latter moderate
breezes Steering W. by N. the Platina
in company Lat 18.10 S Long 41.13 E

Friday 27th first part good breezes
from S. Steering N.W. by W. under all
sail middle part lying aback heading
W.S.W. latter at 2 1/2 P.M. kept off N.W. by
W. at 10 A.M. entered the mouth of Pomba
bay so ends the Platina in Co.

Saturday 28th first part light breezes from
S. beating up Pomba bay in company
with the Platina at 3 P.M. came to
Anchor & went ashore a cutting
wood so ends this day

Sunday 29th all these 24 hours good
weather lying at anchor in Pomba bay

Monday 30th all these 24 hours fine
weather employed in cutting wood and
getting it off & storing it away to dry sea
finished so ends this day

Tuesday July 1st all this day good weather
all hands employed in setting up the bob
stays & martingilles gages and getting
all ready for sea &c
