Employed in mending fore top sail &c
Lat 15° 34' S Long 42° 19' E

Sunday 10th all these 24 hours light
breezes from E. S. E. Steering N. E. by the
wind under all sail Lat " Long do do

Monday 11th all these 24 hours light
breezes from S. E. Steering S. E. by the wind
under all sail Lat 14° 45' S
Long 43° 19' E

Tuesday 12th first part light breezes from
S. E. Steering S. E. middle and latter
strong breezes Steering N. E. by E employed
in mending main top sail do do

Wednesday 13th first part light breezes from
E. S. E. Steering N. E. by the wind with one sail in
sight middle Steering S. N. E. with 1 Mayotte &
Joanna in sight Employed in washing ship
and scraping masts

Thursday 14th first and middle part
Calm latter light breezes from S. Steering
from N. W. to W. employed in painting

Friday 15th first part light breezes
from S. S. W. Steering from W. to W. N. W.
for Johanna at 10 A. M. came to anchor the
Pari and a French slave are here employed in getting
out coals &c

Saturday August 16th 1856
all this day fine weather employed in
fitting casks to get water &c

Sunday 17th good weather the barboard
watch ashore on liberty

Monday 18th good weather employed
in getting off a cask of water & stowing
it down

Tuesday 19th good weather employed
in getting off water and stowing off
between decks &c

Wednesday 20th good weather the
Starboard watch ashore on liberty

Thursday 21st all this day good weather
barboard watch ashore on liberty

Friday 22nd the Starboard watch
ashore on "liberty" so ends this day

Saturday 23rd good weather the L
watch ashore on liberty so ends

Sunday 24th good weather all hands
went ashore part in the fore noon &
the rest in the afternoon

Monday 25th good weather all hands
onboard got off 2 casks of water &
getting ready for sea so ends this day

Tuesday 26th first good weather at
midnight weighed anchor with the Pari
latter light breezes from W. S. W. Steering E. S. E.
