and a fresh breeze from N.E. Lat " Long " E

Monday 22nd all first part fine breezes from
S.E. Steering N by W Middle part Steering by
the wind to the N.W. latter Steering from N.W. to
N.N.W. Lat 30 31 Long 44 31 East

Tuesday 23rd all these 24 hours light winds
from S. Steering S.W. & N.W. employed
in mending the Spantree Lat " Long " E

Wednesday 24th all these 24 hours light
winds from S. Steering N.S.W. by the wind
employed in mending the Spantree & boarding
it so ends this day Lat 25 50 Long 42 35 E

Thursday 25th all these 24 hours good breezes
from S. Steering by the wind. Latter S.W. by W.
employed mending the Fore sail
Lat 25 48 Long 45 53 E

bent the fore sail Lat " Long " E

Saturday 27th All these 24 hours strong

under all sail Lat ends Long 45 00 E

Sunday 28th all these 24 hours good breezes
from S to S.E. Steering E by the wind
under all sail Lat 44 51 Long 44 51 E

Monday 29th all these 24 hours good breezes
from S.E. to S.W. Steering from S.E. to
E Lat 44 51 Long 44 51 East

Tuesday 30th all this day fine breezes
from S.E. Steering on different tacks
by the wind bent the N.E. & staysail
Lat 44 51 Long 44 51 E

Wednesday Oct 1st first part light
breezes from S. Steering N by E Middle
& latter Steering S.W. with a dove in sight
employed in setting up the fore Mast
& N.E. back stays & rigging aft so ends
Lat 44 51 Long 44 51 E

Thursday 2nd all these 24 hours good
winds Steering on different tacks
by the wind under all sail Lat " Long " E

breezes from S.E. Steering S.W. by
the wind under all sail Lat " Long " E
