Sunday, Dec 30. first part strong winds from E.S.E. steering N by E. Middle the same. Latter light winds from S. steering N by E.

Friday 5th first part light breezes from S.W. steering from N.W. to W. N.W. under all sail Middle part calm latter part light breezes from S. to S.E. W. Employed in putting out a new larboard boat & putting the old larboard boat on the waist boat grains so ends this day

Saturday 6th first part light breezes from S to S by W steering N.W. by W under all sail Middle & latter steering N.W. Employed in fitting fore and aft masts

Sunday 7th all these 24 hours fresh breezes from S steering N.W. by W under all sail Lat 33.48 South

Monday 8th first part fresh breezes from S steering N.W. by W Middle & latter light breezes Employed in caulking the larboard boat so ends this day Lat 33.27

Tuesday 9th first part light breezes from S.W. to N.W. by W steering to the N.W. by the wind under all sail latter part the same Lat 33.17
