Monday January 3<sup>rd</sup> 1842

Barom<sup>2</sup> Fore part light winds from North with  
30% P.M. a heavy swell Course E by N all sail set at  
30% A.M. 5:30 Drove led, keeled Fore and Mizen topsails  
Middle part Calm latter light breeze  
from Sth Lat 35.30 Long 41.24 P. Chron 40.39

Tuesday 4<sup>th</sup>

Barom<sup>2</sup> Fore part light winds from the South and  
30% P.M. pleasant Course E by N all sail set employed  
30% A.M. in sundry jobs middle part strong  
breezes latter brisk from Sth  
Lat 36.23 Long 30.55 P. Chron

Wednesday 5<sup>th</sup>

Barom<sup>2</sup> Fore part brisk winds from Sth all  
30% P.M. sail set Course E by N employed in sundry  
30% A.M. jobs middle and latter light winds and  
pleasant Lat 36.40 Long 36.00 P. Chron 35.44

Thursday 6<sup>th</sup>

Barom<sup>2</sup> Fore part light winds and pleasant all sail  
30% P.M. set Course East employed in sundry jobs middle  
30% A.M. and latter brisk breezes Lat 36.46 Long 31.45 P. Chron

Friday 7<sup>th</sup>

Barom<sup>2</sup> Fore part strong breezes from the South all sail  
30% P.M. set Course East at 5 P.M. E by S middle the  
30% A.M. same latter strong wind smooth weather and  
pleasant headed to the East P. Chron Lat 36.39 Long 28.49

Saturday 8<sup>th</sup>

Barom<sup>2</sup> Fore part brisk breezes and squally from Sth  
30% P.M. all sail set Course E by S at 6 P.M. drove led  
30% A.M. the Fore and Mizen led keeled the Main and Mizen  
middle the same latter the wind SE headed  
E by E cloudy weather  
Lat 36.55 Long 26.28 P. Chron

# Voyage

Sunday January 9<sup>th</sup> 1842

Barom<sup>2</sup> Fore part brisk winds and squally from  
30% P.M. Sth all sail set employed in sundry jobs Barometer  
30% A.M. fell 1/10 from 2 P.M. middle part strong winds  
and squally some rain drove led keeled the  
topsails headed to Sth at 1 P.M. veered  
to the East latter headed to Sth (P. Chron  
Lat 36.36 Long 25.56

Monday 10<sup>th</sup>

Barom<sup>2</sup> Fore part strong winds and squally with  
30% P.M. some rain from S. headed E by E all sail  
30% A.M. set employed in sundry jobs middle light  
squalls and Calm latter light winds from  
Sth headed to Sth (Lat 36.25 by P. Chron  
saw the land St. Mark Long P. Chron 25.11  
bearing N by E distance 8 leagues

Tuesday 11<sup>th</sup>

Barom<sup>2</sup> Fore part light winds and pleasant from  
30% P.M. Sth all sail set employed in sundry jobs  
30% A.M. Fore and Mizen top S. Masts middle and  
part the same at 1 P.M. tacked to SE  
at 7:30 A.M. saw Whales lowered and  
Chased Lat 36.09 Long 24.11 P. Chron

Wednesday 12<sup>th</sup>

Barom<sup>2</sup> Fore part light winds from Sth  
30% P.M. Boats of Chasing Whales at 2 P.M. took  
30% A.M. 1 along side got ready for Cutting Barometer  
fell 1/10 from 6 P.M. to 42. middle part strong  
gale parted old fluke Chain to the Whales  
got on the Haused at 9 began to Cut hoops  
ton out parted Haused made sail by the  
Whale Barometer 29% winds hauled to  
the N.W. with some rain and squally
