30.40 AM Fore part strong gales and doubled keel of spruce in reach of our shak at 3 PM took her along side and fluke hopped on line to moderate at 6 PM Barometer 29.70 wind N. N. W. and squally middle part incline to moderate latter light winds with a heavy swell parted our fluke rope in wearing ship took her along side and began to cut

Friday 14th

30.00 AM Fore part strong winds from West and Regret at 3 PM finished cutting the Body laid by the head middle the same latter light winds with a heavy swell took in our head lost off Cape Lat 36.14 - Long 24.22

30.40 AM Fore part light winds and pleasant from N. E. a steering to the South employed in clearing head and Boiling middle and latter light from West Lat 35.44 N Long 23.57

Sunday 16th

30.40 AM Fore part light airs from N. W. a heading to the South employed in Boiling middle and latter light airs finished Boiling Lat 35.29 N Long 23.34 W

30.40 AM Fore part light airs and pleasant from E. S. E. a steering to the South middle and latter strong breezes one sail in sight steering N. N. W. Lat 33.20 Long 24.10 W

30.40 AM Fore strong winds from E. S. E. a steering to the South sent new Foretop sail middle and latter strong breezes headed to the S. S. W. Lat 30.52 Long 24.33 Wind 24.17 P. Chm

30.40 AM Fore part brisk winds and pleasant from N. E. by E all sail set Course S. E. by E at 6 PM steamed S. E. by E one sail in sight middle the same latter S. S. W. pleasant sent up fore and Mizen top S. S. W. Lat 27.44 N Long 21.32 P. Chm

Friday 21st

Barom 30.40
30.40 AM Fore part brisk winds and pleasant all sail set Course S. E. by E employed in sundry jobs 2 sails in sight middle and latter brisk trades and some squally P. Chm Lat 26.56 N Long 20.12 W

Saturday 22nd

Barom 30.40
30.40 AM Fore part strong breezes and pleasant a heading S. E. all sail set employed in sundry jobs stowed out all between decks one sail in sight a standing to the S. S. W. middle and latter strong breezes headed to the S. E. by E Lat 24.07 Long 19.00 W

Sunday 23rd

30.40 AM Fore part strong winds and pleasant from E. a heading to S. E. by E at 4 PM steamed S. E. by E all sail set employed in sundry jobs middle part steamed to South latter steamed S. S. W. Lat 20.50 N Long 18.49 W
