For part brisk winds from ESE. Cloudy headed Southly spoke ship Two Brothers Tincum 200 & middle and latter strong gales with thick rainy weather Lat 22.10 S. Long 100.30

Sunday 5th

For part strong gales from ESE headed Southly with thick rainy weather at 2 PM sudden shift to N. Two Brothers in sight middle and latter light winds and pleasant

Monday 6th

For part light winds from N and pleasant in company with ship Two Brothers headed Easterly middle and latter light winds

Tuesday 7th

For part light winds and pleasant headed Easterly spoke ship Delphus of Tisbury. Canton. Pa. and two Brothers of New Bedford middle light and latter strong winds stand N.E

Lat 22.14 S. Long 110.20 East

Wednesday 8th

For part strong winds from SE headed N.E pleasant night veered ship. Slightly back in sail middle and latter pleasant Lat 21.50 S Long 110.55 E

Thursday 9th

For part light winds and pleasant headed N. Easterly night shortened sail middle and latter brisk breeze Lat 21.34 Long 111.46 East Chron

Friday 10th

For part brisk winds and pleasant headed Easterly at night shortened sail veered to West's middle and latter brisk winds from N.W. headed N.E Lat 21.26 Long 112.20 East

Saturday 11th

For part light winds from S.W. steered to N.W. one sail in sight at night shortened sail middle and latter pleasant Lat 20.00 Long 113.06

Sunday 12th

For part light winds from S.W. pleasant steering N.E latter stand N.E by E Lat 18.55 Long 113.40 Chron 114.02 Lunat

Monday 13th

For part light winds steering E.N.E night shortened sail middle calm latter light airs employed in stowing hooks Lat 18.33 Long 114.16 Chron 114.30 Lunat

Tuesday 14th

For part light winds steering to N.E by E employed in stowing hooks between decks middle part light airs from East latter light airs at 9 AM saw Whales leaved and took one along side Lat 18.07 S Long 114.30 E

Wednesday 15th

For part light winds at 2 PM began to cut out whale at 7 PM washed decks shortened sail heading to the Eastward middle and latter brisk winds employed in Bailing Lat 17.54 S Long 114.54 E

Thursday 16th

For part brisk winds employed in Bailing middle and latter light winds finished Bailing spoke ship Two Brothers Lat 17.32 S Long 115.04 East
