Fore part light winds pleasant in Company
with Ship Two Brothers middle and latter
light airs and Calm Lat 16.39 S Long 115.50

Monday 20th

Fore part light airs from Eastward pleasant in
Company with Two Brothers middle and latter
Calm Lat 16.30 S. Long 116.04 E

Tuesday 21st

Fore part Calm pleasant heading Eastward
in Company Two Brothers middle the same
latter brisk winds from S. headed E & N E
Lat 16.11 S. Long 116.50

Wednesday 22^d

Fore part strong breezes headed to the N E
in Company with Ship Two Brothers middle and latter
brisk winds Lat 14.53 Long 118.00

Thursday 23^d

Fore part brisk winds headed S E pleasant
middle and latter pleasant Lat 13.34 118.4

Friday 24th

Fore part brisk winds headed S E pleasant
at 9 PM veered to N E middle and brisk winds

Lat 12.50 S Long 119.09 E

June 25 1842

Saturday

Fore part pleasant brisk winds headed to
the N E middle and latter strong winds
and rugged Lat 11.03 S. Long 119.20 E

Sunday 26th

Fore part strong winds and rugged headed
to the N E at 4 PM saw the Land Sandal
Wood Island the South point bearing N E
by E & the S W point bearing N E by N distance
6 leagues at 7 PM veered off to South middle
and latter strong winds Lat 10.11 Long 119.50

Monday 27th

Fore part strong winds & working to the East
of the South of Sandal Wood 2 ships in sight
middle and latter strong winds
Lat 10.36 Long 120.03

Tuesday 28th

Fore part strong winds & working to the
Eastward of Sandal Wood the middle the
same latter greatly with rain Sause the
fore N by E distance 6 leagues

Wednesday 29th

Fore part baffling winds at 4 PM boreward
N by E distance 6 leagues headed to N E by E
middle part strong winds latter the same at
9 AM steamed W. S. W. meridian Sause bore
E by N distance 4 leagues

Thursday 30th

Fore part strong winds spoke English Park
Napoleon of Swan River middle part steamed
W. S. W. latter N by E
Lat 9.43 S. Long 117.46 E
