

July 26th 1842 S. Lat. & Long.

Tuesday

Wore part brisk breeze and pleasant some digging heading S. S. E. employed in repairing fore top sail. Ship leaked more than common, in 24 hours mid and latter strong winds doubled kept topsail.

Wednesday 27th

Wore part strong under doubled kept topsail a heading S. E. employed in repairing main top. S. Sail middle and latter brisk winds repairing fore top. S. Sail

Lat 16.04 S. Long 113.09 E

Thursday 28th

Wore part brisk winds and pleasant headed to the South. Employed in repairing fore top. S. Sail bent old fore topsail middle the same latter light winds employed in tarring rigging

Lat 17.30 Long 113.12 E

Friday 29th

Wore part pleasant with light winds employed in tarring rigging heading to the South mid latter headed to East

Lat 17.37 Long 114.39

Saturday 30th

Wore part brisk winds and pleasant employed in sundry head to S. S. at 6 P.M. doubled kept the topsail mainsail banded, middle and latter the same employed in b. g. topsail

Lat 17.27 S. Long 115.51 E

Sunday 31st

Wore part strong winds from South heading S. E. & S. employed in repairing fore sail middle and latter light winds headed to S. S.

Lat 17.34 S. Long 116.03 East

August 1842

Monday 1st

Wore part light winds from Eastward a heading S. S. E. pleasant weather middle the same latter light from the S. S.

Lat 18.28 S. Long 115.22 East

Tuesday 2nd

Wore part light from S. S. and Calm employed in repairing fore topsail middle and latter brisk winds from S. S.

Lat 19.14 S. Long 116.29 E

Wednesday 3rd

Wore part strong winds from South steering N. by S at 3 P.M. squally with thick weather doubled kept the topsail middle and latter brisk gales heading to the West

Lat 19.15 Long 114.25 E

Thursday 4th

Wore part strong wind heading to S. S. & S. under doubled kept topsail middle middle latter strong wind.

Lat 20.24 Long 113.04

Friday 5th

Wore part strong winds a steering S. S. S. at 6 P.M. shortened sail middle and latter light winds

Lat 21.21 S. Long 112.43 E

Saturday 6th

Wore part brisk winds pleasant heading to S. S. middle part light winds latter strong

Lat 22.07 S. Long 111.50 E

Sunday 7th

Wore part strong winds and pleasant headed to S. S. at 6 P.M. bent to E. S. shortened sail middle part pleasant latter fair

Lat 24.58 Long 112.30 E
