For part brisk winds from N. heading to
S. M. employed in Boiling at 1.30 P.M. saw
a sperm whale going fast to the N.
lowered the Boats and chased middle part
strong wind latter brisk gales finished Boiling

Tuesday 6th

For part strong gales from N. headed to the N.
at 4 P.M. went to the N. M. with heavy gale
under E. to Reefed. Main by S. and hence
middle strong gale latter incline to moderate
employed in stowing down oil

Wednesday 7th

For part strong wind and lugged employed
in stowing oil middle and latter brisk wind
headed to the N.

Thursday 8th

For part brisk winds and some squally
heading to the S. M. middle and latter

For part strong gales from West headed to
the N. M. at 6 P.M. went to the S. middle
part strong gales latter incline to moderate
Latt 30.54 Long 111.44 E.M.

Wednesday 14th

For part strong gales and lugged from the N.
headed to S. M. at 6 P.M. to the N. M. spoke
Ship Lagoda Maxfield N.P. 1200 lbs
middle and latter light winds.
Latt 30.23 S.

Thursday 15th

For part light winds and some squally
in Company with Ship Lagoda heading
to S. M. middle and latter the same
Proke out Shark Heads found half rotten
Latt 30.15 Long 111.00

Friday 16th

For part brisk winds and some squally heading
to S. M. in Company with Ship Lagoda middle
and latter strong winds spoke Bark Elizabeth
Moulton 800 lbs headed to the S. M.
