Saturday 17th

Fore part strong gales from W heading to the S. under short sail at 6 PM went ship to the N. W. Bark in sight middle part strong gales latter inclines to moderate

Lat 29.37. S Long 111.20 E

Sunday 18th

Fore part strong winds from S W heading to the S. under short sail at 6 PM went ship to the N. W. Bark in sight middle part strong gales latter inclines to moderate

Lat 29.35 S Long 110.46 E

Monday 19th

Fore part light winds from N. a steering S W all sail at 6 PM shortened sail headed to S W latter strong winds fore part (Bark) latter

Lat 30.04 Long 110.34 E

Tuesday 20th

Fore part strong winds under short sail headed to S W in company with Bark Elizabeth middle and latter light winds

Wednesday 21st

Fore part light winds from N W headed to S. in company with Bark Elizabeth middle part strong winds from N. with rain latter strong gales from N W

Lat 30.17 Long 110.34 E

Thursday 22^d

Fore part strong gales from N W a heading to S. middle and latter strong gales

Lat 31.14 Long 111.15 E

Friday 23th

Fore part strong gales from N W headed to the S W at 6 PM went to S W middle and latter strong winds Ship Lagoda in sight

Lat 31.16 Long 111.24

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Saturday 24th

Fore part strong winds from N a heading to the S W (Ship Lagoda in sight) under double reefed topsails at 3 PM lost Overboard from jib boom the Mendocino and was drowned toward end Boat could not save him middle part strong gales latter inclines to moderate

Lat 32.20 S Long 111.57 E

Sunday 25th

Fore part strong wind with a heavy swell from N a heading to S middle steered to the S W latter strong wind steered to S E

Lat 34.20 Long 112.00

Monday 26th

Fore part strong gales from N W a heading to the S E under short sail at 5 PM hauled to the West on sail in sight middle and latter the same

Tuesday 27th

Fore part strong gales from N a heading to S W middle the same latter steered to the E

Lat 35.16 S Long 113.12 E

Wednesday 28th

Fore part strong gales from West a steering East at 5 PM hauled to S W middle and latter more moderate

Lat 35.17 S Long 114.26 E

Thursday 29th

Fore part fresh winds steering East spoke Bark Arab Fairhaven 1000 lbs 700 of Opium middle and latter pleasant weather

Lat 35.25 Long 115.20 E
