S.W. at night shortened sail middle and latter strong
winds Lat 38.05 Long 116.50 E

Saturday 5th

Fore part strong winds and squally from West
steering to E at night shortened sail headed to
the S. middle and latter strong winds
Lat 38.40 Long 116.00

Sunday 6th

Fore part strong winds from N.W. steering to the
N. said on sail middle and latter strong winds
Lat 37.34 Long 118.25 E

Monday 7th

Fore part strong winds inclining to moderate a
steering E.S.E. all sail at 7 P.M. shortened sail
headed to S.E. winds S.W. middle light
latter light winds from N.W. steered E.S.E.
