Chase 2 galled Whales Could not strike Hope in sight
middle and latter brisk winds from S.W.

For part fine breeze and pleasant no Whales in sight
saw Wh. Hope Whaling middle and latter thick
weather Lat 40.51

Saturday 26th

For part strong winds with thick weather saw
Wh. Hope saw Whales going fast to S.W. middle
and latter thick weather Lat 40.35 Long 121.00

Sunday 27th

For part strong breeze from S.W. with thick weather
struck a Whale and hauled middle and latter
thick fog Lat by the 40.10 Long 121.12

Monday 28th

For part light airs and calm on sail in sight
middle and latter light winds and pleasant
Lat 40.46 Long 121.00 E

For part strong winds from S.W. pleasant heading
to the East under double reefed top sails and
courses at 6 P.M. shortened sail middle and
latter strong winds spoke ship Sabina of New
York Cap. Hale 500. 1000 Spinn Thomas Desbross
Laggarbad 2700 600 Havers Tice Brother New B
1000. 400 Spinn Lat 40.33 Long 122.25

Sunday 4th

For part strong winds from the S.W. saw a Whale
covered Could not strike middle and latter strong
winds and foggy Lat 40.30 Long 122.00 E

Monday 5th

For part strong winds from S.W. and foggy
saw a Whale at 6 P.M. took him along side middle
and latter light winds with a bad swell cut in
and Whale lost his head Lat 40.37 Long 123.48

Tuesday 6th

For part light airs and calm employed in Boating
2 sail in sight middle and latter light winds
and pleasant
