For part light winds and pleasant. Headed to the
S. E. employed in Boiling saw a Whale leaved and
Sunk him middle and latter pleasant finished
Boiling employed in stowing down oil in the Main
Hole Lat 41.11. Long 124.10 E

Thursday 8th

For part light airs and Calm. Headed to the S. E.
middle Calm latter light winds from N. E. steered to
South Lat 41.29 S. Long 124.42

Friday 9th

For part light winds from N. N. E. heading to the
middle part brisk winds latter strong winds from
N. steered E. by S. Lat 42.53. Long 126.12

Saturday 10th

For part strong winds from N. N. W. and thick steam
East middle and latter strong breeze and thick
weather Lat 42.57 Long 129.39 E
Sun 11th 129.29

Sunday 11th

For part strong wind steering to E. by N. all sail
at 7 P. M. shortened sails middle part strong gales
at Midnight hauled to the N. at 6 A. M. steered
to E. Lat 42.20 Long 132.00 E

Monday 12th

For part strong gales with thick weather
Heading to the E. at 6 P. M. hove to headed to
the N. E. middle and latter strong gales from
N. Lat 41.30 Long 133.42

Tuesday 13th

For part strong gales from S. E. headed to S. E. under
short sail middle part incline to moderate steam
E latter light winds with a heavy swell
Lat 41.30 Long 135.26 E

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Wednesday 14th

For part light winds from N. steering E. S. E. employed
repairing Fore sail middle and latter fine breeze
from N. on ship in sight standing to S. E.
Lat 42.16 Long 138.26

Thursday 15th

For part light breeze from N. steering E. all sail set
middle and latter light winds saw 2 Right
Whales Struck Both drew from one saved the
other Lat 42.16 Long 140.20 E

Friday 16th

For part light winds at 2 P. M. took on a Whale
alongside and cut him in middle and latter light
airs employed in Boiling Lat 42.20 Long 140.23

Saturday 17th

For part light wind from East heading to the S.
employed in Boiling middle and latter strong
winds from E. Lat 43.09 Long 140.37 E

Sunday 18th

For part brisk wind from E. heading to N. N. E.
finished Boiling employed in stowing middle and
latter strong winds and thick weather finished stowing
Lat 43.12 S. Long 141.29 E

Monday 19th

For part strong gales from N. N. E. and thick weather
heading to the E. middle part the same latter
strong winds from N. N. E. saw a Brigg steering to E. S. E.
Lat 43.33 Long 143.20

Tuesday 20th

For part strong winds from N. N. E. steering E. S. E.
all sail set middle part the same latter saw
the land
