Fore part light winds and pleasant a heading
to the N. W. by N. all sail set shifted Main top sail
middle and latter pleasant from N. E.
Lat 30.09 Long 151.11 East of the

Friday 13th

Fore part brisk winds from S. E. a heading to
the N. W. all sail set at 6 PM shortened sail
steared to E. by S. middle and latter
strong winds Lat 37.41 S. Long 151.24 E

Saturday 14th

Fore part strong winds from N. E. and heavy
a heading to the N. W. by N. under dowed reefed
top sail at 4 PM saw the land Cape Howe.
New Holland bearing N. W. distance 34 leagues
saw ship to the E. E. saw a Bark steaming N. W. E.
middle part light wind latter brisk from
S. W. Lat 37.39 Long 150.17

Sunday 15th

Fore part strong winds from S. W. a driving a gale
