Monday 16th

Fore part brisk winds from N.E. and thick weather at 6 P.M. shortened sail headed to E.S.E. distance from the land 3 leagues middle and latter thick weather with rain

Tuesday 17th

Fore part strong winds from S.W. and cloudy one sail in sight at 6 P.M. shortened sail headed to S.E. distance from the land 2 leagues middle and latter brisk gales Lat 36.32 Long 154.46

Wednesday 18th

Fore part strong gales from S. a steering N.E. and doubled reefed top sail at 4.30 P.M. shortened sail headed to E by S. middle the same latter strong wind and rugges at 8 P.M. saw Spinn. Whales lowered the Boats could not strike

Lat 36.34 S. Long 151.45

Thursday 19th

Fore part strong winds from S.W. a steering to the Windward after Whales at 2 P.M. lost sight of them at 6 P.M. shortened sail headed to E by S. middle and latter light wind and fine weather Lat 36.20 Long 151.52 E

Friday 20th

Fore part light winds from N.E. a heading to the N. at 6 P.M. shortened sail headed to the E.S.E. middle and latter strong winds from the N. Lat 36.02 Long 153.12 E

Saturday 21st

Fore part strong winds from N. a steering E by N. at 6 P.M. shortened sail middle and latter brisk winds Lat 36.12 Long 155.17 E

Sunday 22nd

Fore part brisk wind from the N. and pleasant steering to the E by N. at 6 P.M. shortened sail middle and latter the same latter wind headed to N.E. Lat 36.00 by the Long by the 154.43

Monday 23

Fore part brisk winds from S.W. at 4 past meridian saw Spinn. Whales lowered the Boats struck 2 and drewed went along side 2 more and missed them middle and latter strong winds Lat 35.43 Long 157.10

Tuesday 24

Fore part strong winds and rugges a heading to the E. at 6 P.M. veered this to the S.W. middle and latter fine weather saw Spinn. Whales Boats in Chase Lat 35.40 Long 156.40

Wednesday 25

Fore pleasant Boats in Chase of Whales struck 1 boat the line middle and latter fine weather Lat 35.31 Long 156.22 E

Thursday 26

Fore part brisk breezes from N.E. steering to the S.E. at 7 P.M. shortened sail headed to the E. middle and latter fine Breezes from N. Lat 36.30 Long 156.40 E

Friday 27th

Fore part brisk winds from N. a steering E by N. at 6 P.M. shortened sail middle and latter light winds and pleasant on sail in sight standing to the N.E. Lat 36.07 S. Long 157.43
