

April 1843 S. Lat. East Long.

Friday 14th Lord Howe Island

For part brisk breeze from S.W. a heading to N.W. by N. hauled to port, middle and latter light airs and calm S. Lat 35.13 Long 160.30 E

Saturday 15th

For part light winds from N.W. and pleasant heading to S.W. by S. middle and latter strong winds S. Lat 35.54 Long 160.24 E

Sunday 16th

For part brisk gales from N.W. under short sail heading to N.W. by N. middle and latter strong gales same rain S. Lat 36.04 Long 160.36 E

Monday 17th

For part strong gales from N.W. a heading to N.W. under short sail middle and latter the same under single reefed to port heading to N.W. by N. S. Lat 34.27 Long 160.44 E

Tuesday 18th

For part strong winds from N.W. under single reefed to port a heading to the N.W. at 5.30 PM shortened sail middle and latter brisk breezes S. Lat 32.40 Long 159.46 E

Wednesday 19th

For part light winds from N.W. a heading to the N.W. by N. at 5.30 PM saw the Land Bath Pyramid Bearing N.W. by N distance 15 leagues shortened sail middle and latter light winds and squalls from N.W. S. Lat 32.28 Long 159.58 E

Thursday 20th

For part light winds from S. a steering N.W. for Lord Howe Island at 5.30 shortened sail Bath Pyramid Bore N.W. distance 6 leagues middle and latter light winds at meridian S. of Lord Howe Is. bore - 28 distance 14 leagues

Friday 21st

For part light winds from S. landed on Lord Howe Island middle light airs from E. latter light from N.E. Boats on shore for Hogg

Saturday 22nd

For part light winds from N. 2 Boats on shore at Lord Howe Island for Refreshments to take on Board Sir Hogg shortened sail middle and latter strong winds from N. at 4 Boats on shore Meridian

Sunday 23rd

For part strong winds from N.W. heading to the S.W. by S. the Pyramid at 6 PM Pyramid Bore N.W. distance 34 leagues heading to E. by N. middle part light airs and calm heading to the N. latter strong winds S. Lat 31.33 Long 159.44 E

Monday 24th

For part strong winds from S. a steering N.W. at 2 PM Lord Howe Island bore N.W. distance 16 leagues at 5.30 PM shortened sail middle and latter brisk winds heading to the N.E. spoke Bark Headland of Sydney 300 N.W. 15 weather but S. Lat 30.22 Long 160.35 E

Tuesday 25th

For part strong winds from N.W. a heading to the N.W. in company with Bark Headland middle part the same latter calm with rain S. Lat 29.34 Long 160.47 E

Wednesday 26th

For part light airs and calm a heading to the N. Woodlark in sight middle part a heavy gale commenced with a heavy squall with Thunder and Lightning latter strong gales wind N.W. by N. S. Lat 28.28 Long 160.30 E
