

May 1842 New Caledonia

Thursday 23rd Tuesday

Fore part brisk wind from SE and pleasant steering N.W. in Comp. with Hesper sent in Jell. Room it being strong and rotten Rigger sent a spare Main yard in its place middle and tail pleasant Lat 19.32 Long 162.30 E

Wednesday 24th

Fore part light winds and pleasant from E. a steering to the N.W. middle part laid by heading to the S.W. latter steered to the N.W. Lat 18.37 S. Long 162.10 E

Thursday 25th

Fore part light winds from SE at 3 PM commenced with strong winds and Rain from S.W. laid by heading to the West middle part the same latter steered to the SE Lat 17.27 S. Long 161.50 E

Friday 26th

Fore part strong winds from SE a steering to the N.W. by E under double reefed topsails middle and latter strong winds Lat 16.29 S. Long 163.00 E

Saturday 27th

Fore part strong winds from SE a heading to the N.W. by E under double reefed topsails middle and latter strong wind Lat by the 15.40 S Long " 163.35 E

Sunday 28th

Fore part strong winds from E. a heading to the N.W. under double reefed topsails middle the same latter light winds from N.W. by E headed to SE Lat by the 15.20 S. Long 164.23 E

May 1843 New Hebrides

Monday 29th

Fore part light wind from E. a heading to the SE middle part squally with rain and lightning latter strong winds under double reefed topsails Lat 15.34 S. Long 164.53 E

Tuesday 30th

Fore part brisk breeze from SE a heading to the E. a heading to the N.W. at night shortened sail middle and latter fine breeze and pleasant at 9 AM saw the land Epivie's Santo bearing 8 distance 15 leagues Long 166.00 Lat 14.58 S. Long at 2 PM 166.22 P. Chem 20 miles off the land

Wednesday 31st

Fore part brisk wind and pleasant a heading of the S.W. by W middle wind in to the E. a heading to the N.W. latter light E. a heading to the N.W. Distance from the land 2 leagues Lat 14.46 Long P. Chem 166.238 Long of ship by the land 166.00

Thursday June 1

Fore part light winds of the N.W. Part of the land at 6 PM the point bore 46 distance 3 leagues steered to the N.W. middle and latter brisk wind Lat 14.28 Long 165.55

Friday 2nd

Fore part brisk wind a Cruising of the North of Santo middle and latter strong winds spoke Bark Hesper a sailing Lat 14.17 Long 165.58

Saturday 3rd

Fore part strong winds from SE a heading to S.W. in company with Hesper at night steered to the N.W. by E middle and latter light winds and pleasant a heading in for Bank's Island distance 5 leagues Lat 13.41 S. Long 167.77 P. Chem Sun West - Long 167.28 Lat 13.41
