 Fore part light winds from from SSE a heading to the at 5.30 P.M. lowered reefed the topsail headed to the S.W. by S distance from the land 6 leagues middle and latter light winds from S.W.

Sunday 9th
 Fore part light winds from S.W. at 3 P.M. saw school of Sperm Whales struck 3 took 2 along side drew from the other middle and latter pleasant Cut in our Whales Lat 16.00 Long 179.20 E

Monday 10th
 Fore part light airs and pleasant from SSE employed in Boiling at 6 P.M. shortened sail distance from the land 15 miles middle and latter fine weather Lat 16.06 Long 179.25 E

Tuesday 11th
 Fore part fine breeze and fine weather distance from the land 6 miles at 4 P.M. lowered in a school of Sperm Whales struck 5 lost a line and took 4 along side at 9.30 A.M. Cut in our Whales made sail and fell in with a dead Whale took him along side distance from the land 10 miles

Wednesday 12th
 Fore part light winds Cut in our whale employed in Chasing away heads and Boiling middle and latter fine weather employed in Boiling

 Fore part fine weather employed in Boiling distance from the land at 6 P.M. 9 miles middle and latter pleasant finished Boiling

Friday 14th
 Fore part light winds and pleasant at 6 P.M. distance from the land 6 miles middle and latter pleasant Sperm Whales in sight distance from the land 10 miles

Saturday 15th
 Fore part brisk winds and pleasant at 1.30 P.M. lowered for the Whales struck 2 drew from 1 Cut from 1 middle and latter brisk winds pleasant employed in storing down oil distance from land 8 miles

Sunday 16th
 Fore part brisk winds employed in storing oil at 6 P.M. saw a school of Whales to starboard to lower shortened sail distance from the land 10 miles middle and latter pleasant

Monday 17th
 Long by land 179.10 by Chm 179.28 24
 Fore part brisk winds and pleasant at 5.30 P.M. distance from the land 8 miles middle and latter strong winds and greatly from SSE

Tuesday 18th
 Fore part strong winds and greatly from SSE saw Sperm Whales lowered and galled them distance from land 5 miles middle and latter strong winds distance from reef 2 1/2 miles
