Tuesday 1st

For part brisk winds from SSE spoke
Ship Panama Cummings 16 months out
200 bbl sperm at 6 PM distance from Reef
4 miles middle and latter pleasant

Wednesday 2^d

 For part brisk winds and pleasant at 6 PM
distance from Reef 6 miles middle and latter
strong winds and heavy at 11 AM saw a short
sperm Whales lowered the Boats and lost sight
of them Whales

Thursday 3^d

For part strong winds at 6 PM distance from
Reef 3 miles middle and latter strong winds

Friday 4th

 For part strong winds and heavy at 6 PM
distance from Reef 8 miles middle and latter
brisk winds saw a school of sperm Whales struck
and drawn in Company with Panama

Saturday 5th

For part strong wind and pleasant at 6 PM
distance from Reef 4 miles middle and latter
light airs from NNE

Sunday 6th

For part at light airs from NNE at 6 PM
distance from Reef 3 1/2 miles Panama in sight
middle and latter light winds from ESE

Monday 7th

 For part light winds and pleasant
middle and latter the same at 6 AM saw
a large Whale going fast to the Eastward lowered
in Company with the Panama could not catch
him distance from Reef 4 miles

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Tuesday 8th

For part light wind some squally with rain
in Company with Ship Panama at 6 PM
distance from Reef 4 miles middle and latter
pleasant employed in stowing oil

Wednesday 9th

For part strong breezes employed in stowing oil
at 6 PM distance from Reef 6 miles middle
and latter strong winds with thick weather
some rain

Thursday 10th

For part brisk breezes from SE at 6 PM
distance from Reef 6 miles middle and latter
strong winds with thick weather

Friday 11th

Departure For part strong winds from SE and thick
from weather middle and latter part strong
Tackanora, winds at 9 AM steamed to the Westward
distance from land 10 miles

Lat 16.13 Long 178.4, 8

Saturday 12th

For part strong winds from SE a steaming
to the W at 6 PM shortened sail headed to
the SE Reef in sight distance 6 miles
middle and latter the same strong winds steaming
to SE

Lat 16.17 S. Long 177.33 E

Sunday 13th

For part strong winds steaming SE at 6 PM
distance from SE Group of Islands 10 miles
middle brisk winds at 11:30 PM ^{passed} a ship a heading
in for the land at 2:30 AM hauled up to SE
latter light winds headed to the South

Lat 17.52 S. Long 176.23 East
