Saturday 7th Pleasant Charing again for sea at 10 AM

Pilot came on Board got the ship underway for sea at 1 PM visited by Police Boat at 2 PM

Pilot left the North Head of Sidney Bay at 2 PM

Ined South Head bore North headed off to SE by S employed in stowing anchors and Chains and Charing ship for Whaling latter strong breeze

Lat 34.00 Long 157.43 E

Sunday 8th

For part strong winds from SE by E heading by the wind to E by S to SE by E all sail set at 6 PM single reefed the topsail. middle part strong winds at 10 AM and Night Whales under ship's Bows toward the Boat could not strike strong winds and rugged clouds kept the topsail

Lat 34.32 S. Long 153.20 E

Monday 9th

For part strong winds and very rugged headed to the SE saw several Right Whales toward the Boat could not strike middle and latter strong breeze from SE with thick weather

Lat 34.36 S. Long 153.00 E

Tuesday 10th

For part light air from SE and Calm sent down fore topsail to repair at 5 PM saw a Right Whale toward could not strike middle and latter light winds saw many Whales could not strike

Lat 35.06 S. Long 153.10 E

Wednesday 11th

For part light air and calm at 10 PM took a Night whale along side middle and latter light winds from North East in our Whales in sight
