from N. and heavy employed in Boiling

Friday 13th

For part brisk winds from the N. and heavy
at 4 P.M. wind hauled to S.W. and 2 Right
Whales to take to lower middle and latter the
weather on sail in right a Boiling
Lat 35.36 Long 152.04 E

Saturday 14th

For part light winds from N. and Right Whale
bowed Could not strike middle and latter
brisk gales employed in towing and Boiling
Lat 35.27 S. Long 151.56

Sunday 15th

For part strong winds and lugged from South
employed in towing finished Boiling middle
and latter light winds and Whales
Lat by the 35.20 Long the 152.1

Monday 16th

For part light winds from N.W. and Whales
Could not strike middle strong winds latter
strong gales from S.W. Lat 35.46 Long 152.15

Tuesday 17th

For part strong gales from S. heading to S.W.
at 4 P.M. veered to N.W. middle and latter
strong gales
Lat 36.00 S Long 151.36 E

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Wednesday 18th

For part strong gales from S. and Right
Whales to lugged for the Boats middle the
same latter light winds from N. with
heavy swell from S.W. Lat 36.26 Long 151.13

Thursday 19th

For part brisk winds from N. and Right
Land Whales Could not strike distance from the
land 13 leagues middle part strong gales
latter strong from S.W. steering to N.E.
Lat 36.32 Long 151.30 E

Friday 20th

For part strong gales from S.W. steering to
the N.E. under short sail middle and latter
strong winds Lat 35.51 S. Long 151.45

Saturday 21st

For part brisk winds from S.W. heading
to S. at 6 P.M. veered to S.W. under double
topped to S. middle and latter light winds from
N. steered to S.W. Lat 36.20 S. Long 151.52 E

Sunday 22nd

For part strong winds from S. heading to S.W.
middle and latter strong gales here to
Lat 37.33 S Long 151.20 E

Monday 23rd

For part strong gales from S.W. heading to S.W.
under short sail at 3 P.M. veered to S.W. middle
and latter strong gales from S.W. heading to N.W.
Lat 36.49 S. Long 151.46 E

Tuesday 24th

For part strong gales from S.W. under short sail
heading to N.W. at 6 P.M. veered to S. middle part
the same latter light winds from S.W.
Lat 37.23 S Long 151.55 E
