Wednesday 25th

Fore part light winds from N.W. a heading to S.W. at 4 P.M. lured and struck a Right Whale at 6 P.M. took him along side lather strong winds from N.E. and lugged Cut in our Whale
Lat 37.43 Long 152.00 E

Thursday 26th

Fore part strong winds from S.W. a heading S.E. at 4 P.M. veered to N.W. middle and lather part light winds from E.N.E. and 2 sperm Whales got on Iron slightly in our Flat it out
Lat 37.37 S. Long 152.04

Friday 27th

Fore part strong winds from E.N.E. and Right Whale Could not strike middle and lather strong gales from N.E. Lat 37.17 S. Long 152.20 E

Saturday 28th

Fore part strong gales from N.E. at 9 P.M. shifted in a gale from S.W. middle and lather the same Lat 36.52 S. Long 152.85 E

Sunday 29th

Fore part strong gales from S.W. a heading to the S.E. middle the same lather strong winds and lugged saw Right Whales Could not strike Lat 37.20 Long 152.50

Monday 30th

Fore part light winds from N.W. at 6 P.M. took a Right Whale along side a great many Whales in sight middle and lather strong winds with some rain Cut in our Whale

Lat 36.55 Long 152.55 E

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Tuesday 31st

Fore part strong winds several Whales in sight at 5 P.M. took one along side middle and lather strong winds and lugged Cut in our Whale Lat 36.45 Long 153.11 E

Wednesday Oct 1st

Fore part light winds from N.W. headed to S. employed in Boiling saw Right Whales to take to lower middle and lather light winds and pleasant took a Right Whale Cut him in Lat 37.00 Long 153.20 E

Thursday 2nd

Fore part light winds and pleasant employed in Boiling saw Right Whale Could not strike middle and lather light winds and thick weather took a Right Whale and began to Cut Lat 37.03 Long 153.46 E

Friday 3rd

Fore part light wind with thick weather at 1 P.M. Cut in our Whale employed in Boiling middle and lather light winds employed in stowing and Boiling saw Right Whales Could not strike Lat 37.00 Long 153.00 E

Saturday 4th

Fore part light winds employed in Boiling struck a Whale and drove middle and lather strong winds as Lat 36.43 S. Long 152.30 E

Sunday 5th

Fore part strong winds from S.W. and lugged employed in Boiling at 9 finished middle and lather light winds employed in stowing took a Right Whale Lat 37.00 Long 152.40 E
Saw 2 Boats hurt 3 men killed
