Thursday 11th For part strong winds from N.E. pleasant in Company with Bark Hecla middle and latter strong winds Lat 35.50 S Long 158.45 E

Friday 12th

For part light winds and heavy from E at 6 P.M. saw Sperm Whale at 8 P.M. took 1 along side latter cut him in spoke the Bark Mary Widney 1100 lbs

Lat 35.35 S Long 159.30 E

Saturday 13th

For part light winds employed in Boiling 7 ships in right struck a large Whale killed him got foul line cut it being dark lost him middle and latter light winds at 9 A.M. spoke Bark Hecla 9.50 saw a Dead Whale took him along side and began to cut

Lat 35.30 Long 159.50

Sunday 14th

For part light winds from E.S. employed in Cutting and Boiling middle and latter strong winds finished Boiling spoke ship James Lapet Congdon 530 lbs several ships in sight Lat 36.03 Long 159.40 E

Tuesday 16th

For part strong winds from N. at 4 P.M. shifted to Sth with rain middle and latter brisk gale employed in towing Lat 35.30 Long 160.25 E

Wednesday 17th

For part strong gale from Sth employed in towing middle and latter light winds found several Whales took him by the (one) struck a Sperm Whale cleared several ships in sight a Whaling Lat 35.07 Long

January 1844

Thursday 18th

For part light winds from E saw Sperm Whale took 1 along side middle and latter light winds cut in our Whale

Lat 35.14 S Long 159.30 E

Friday 19th

For part light winds employed in Cutting middle and latter brisk winds employed in Boiling Lat 35.23 S Long 159.33 E

Saturday 20th

For part strong winds from N.E. pleasant employed in Boiling several sails in right middle and latter strong winds from S.E. finished Boiling spoke Bark Lagrange 1200 Sperm 300 Whale Lat 35.35 Long 159.30 E

Sunday 21th

For part strong gale from E.S. under short sail a heading to S several sails in right middle and latter strong gale Lat 35.15 S Long 159.31 E

Monday 22nd

For part strong gale from S.E. a heading to Sth under short sail middle and latter strong winds employed in towing Lat 35.35 Long 159.01 E

Tuesday 23rd

For part strong winds spoke Bark Hecla middle and latter strong winds and thick weather Lat 35.10 S Long 159.00 E

Wednesday 24th

For part strong winds from E.S. thick weather several sails in right middle and latter strong winds Lat 35.52 Long 159.01 E
