Friday 22nd

For part light breeze from N. Course E.S. all sail set at 3 P.M. wind headed to S.E. middle part light variable latter brisk winds from E.S. head to South

Lat 45.07 S. Long 151.00 W

Saturday 23rd

For part strong breeze from E.S. a heading to the S at 3.30 P.M. wind to S.E. & E. all sail set middle and latter strong winds

Lat 44.00 S. Long 149.30 W

Sunday 24th

For part brisk gales from E.S. undr dowed reefed topsails headed to N.E. at 6 P.M. close reefed hand jib Mainmast middle and latter strong gales a trying to wear short sail Lat 43.00 Long 140.22 W

Monday 25th

For part strong gale from S.E. a trying to wear short sail at midnight the wind hauled to S. set dowed reefed topsails headed to the E. latter strong winds from the Course E.S. Lat 43.12 S. Long 144.26 W

Tuesday 26th

For part strong wind from S. all sail set Course E.S. middle and latter the same Lat 44.14 S. Long 143.04 W

Wednesday 27th

For part brisk winds from N.E. all sail set Course E.S. middle and latter light and

Lat 44.50 S. Long 140.42 P.M.
Sun West Long 141.10 P.M.

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Thursday 28th

For part light wind from S. all sail set Course E.S. middle and latter light and from South Lat 45.10 S. Long 139.16 W

Friday 29th

For part light breeze from South all sail set a heading to E.S. at 4 P.M. wind light from E.S. middle and latter light breeze from S. and Calm Lat 45.25 S. Long 139.17 W 25

Saturday 30th

For part Calm middle and latter the same Lat 45.20 S. Long 139.16 W

Sunday 31st

For part light breeze from S. and Calm middle and the same latter strong winds from S. a heading to the E Lat 45.30 S. Long 139.10 W

Monday 1st April

For part strong winds from S. all sail set Course E.S. middle headed to N.E. latter headed to E. wind of dowed reefed topsails Lat 45.10 S. Long 134.20 W

Tuesday 2nd

For part strong winds and squally with thick weather from S. Course E.S. undr dowed reefed topsails middle and latter the same Lat 45.22 S. Long 130.58 W

Wednesday 3rd

For part strong winds and squally with heavy weather all sail set a heading to S. at 8 P.M. dowed reefed the topsails middle and latter the same Lat 45.31 S. Long 120.11 W
