from N W and clear weather. Middle
Moderate all sail set by the wind to
the W - latter part calm - at 8 A M
spoke the Bark ship Gaspee of N B
saw 8 Whales saw Finbacks no
right Whales

Remarks on board Saturday Jan 7
These 24 hours commenced with a
calm - Middle the same to the latter part
light breeze from N all sail set to the
N W - at 9 A M saw one Whale
going quick lowered without success
saw many Finbacks and one ship
sailing - employed at mending
sails

Remarks on board Sunday Jan 8
All these 24 hours light windy from
N N W and fine weather all sail set
to the N W first part saw many
Finbacks latter part saw right Whales
lowered the boats and the L Boat
took one to the ship - spoke ship
Palace of Haver 1400 lbs of oil
