Remarks on Board Tuesday May 2

These 24 hours strong wind from  
SSE and clear. At 5 A.M. we  
got under sail and proceeded to  
sea. This day ends with strong  
wind from SE with a rough sea  
at 10 double reefed the Topsails

Latitude  $23^{\circ} 45'$

Remarks on Board Wednesday May 3

All these 24 hours a Gale from  
SE at 1 P.M. took in the Fore  
and Mizzen Topsails and  
close reefed the Main Top sail  
and reefed the Foresail  
standing by the wind to the SW

Latitude  $24^{\circ} 24'$

Longitude  $42^{\circ} 15'$

Remarks on Board Thursday May 4

These 24 hours commenced with a Gale from  
SE ship hove too by the wind to the SW  
at 4 P.M. saw a standing to the SE -  
latter part more moderate at 6 A.M.  
wound up to the SE and set double  
reef Topsails - employed at coiling  
new lines &c. Latitude  $24^{\circ} 09'$

These 24 hours light wind from SE  
and clear weather all sail set by the wind  
to the SE - saw no Whales - employed at  
ships duty - Latitude  $23^{\circ} 39'$   
Longitude  $41^{\circ} 50'$

Remarks on Board Saturday May 5

These 24 hours light wind from  
ESE to SSE all sail set on different  
tacks - at 8 A.M. took up 1000 lbs  
board to Augustin Bay

Latitude  $23^{\circ} 18'$

Longitude  $42^{\circ} 00'$

Remarks on Board Sunday May 7 1837

These 24 hours light breeze from SE  
and clear pleasant weather all sail set  
by the wind to the SW - saw no Whales -  
Latitude  $23^{\circ} 30'$   
Longitude  $41^{\circ} 27'$

Remarks on Board Monday May 8

These 24 hours commenced with light  
wind from SE all sail set on different  
tacks - Middle and latter part calm  
Latitude  $25^{\circ} 40'$   
Longitude -

Remarks on Board Tuesday May 9

These 24 hours nearly calm - employed  
at ships duty - saw no Whales -  
Latitude  $25^{\circ} 45'$   
Longitude  $41^{\circ} 48'$

Remarks on Board Wednesday May 10

These 24 hours commenced with light  
wind from SE Middle and latter  
part strong wind and rough sea -  
at 10 A.M. saw whales heave to the  
windward - Latitude  $24^{\circ} 10'$   
Longitude  $41^{\circ} 03'$
